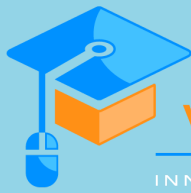

WHAT IS VIRTUAL EDUCATION?:

Osceola Virtual School (OVS) is an internet-based learning environment where instruction takes place online, and is facilitated by certified teachers from Osceola County. Learn where you want 24/7!

WHO CAN TAKE OVS CLASSES?:

OVS provides free part-time virtual school opportunities for students in Grades 6-12 and full-time opportunities for students in Grades K-12 who live in Osceola County. Full-time OVS students are eligible to receive a high school diploma.

WHO IS A GOOD FIT FOR VIRTUAL EDUCATION?

Students who succeed with virtual education learning possess the following characteristics:

- **Computer Literacy** - Students should be familiar with the use of the computer hardware and software, management of files, software installation, and use of communication tools, such as emails and discussion posts, such as Zoom.
- **Strong Reading and Writing Skills** - Online students communicate through text-based tools, such as e-mails, discussion forums, chats, and instant messaging.
- **Self Motivation and Personal Independence** - While online students have more flexibility, students must be willing to work on their own, which requires self discipline.
- **Time Management** - Online classes take as much time as classes at a traditional school. The recommended amount of study time per day is six to seven hours.
- **Active Learning Engagement** - Students must ask questions, develop virtual projects, and communicate with the instructor.
