Celebration High School is a comprehensive educational learning community that is dedicated to the preparation of students to be life-long learners and contributing members in a rapidly changing world. The school has a current student enrollment of 2,730 students with a senior class of 674. The diverse student body is approximately 64% Multiracial, 28% White, 10% Black, 6% Asian, and 1% American Indian. Approximately 43% of students qualify for free or reduced lunch. CHS received a "B" grade in 2018-2019 for its Florida School Grade.

What is the IB Diploma Programme?

The Diploma Programme (DP) is a curriculum framework designed by the International Baccalaureate (IB) for students in the last two years of high school.

IB Students graduating with the IB diploma are able to study at universities all around the world, often with advanced credit. Students report that their involvement with the IB has given them the tools needed to succeed at college. In particular, students comment on their sense of preparedness, self-confidence, research skills and their ability to manage their time. Even more important, they have developed a sense of the world around them and their responsibility to it.

How do colleges and universities view the Diploma Programme?

The Diploma Programme is internationally recognized as representing one of the highest standards in university preparatory education. More than 1,000 colleges and universities in North America have recognition policies on how they weight it in admissions, advanced standing, college credit and scholarships.

Is the IB Programme a good fit for you?

The IB Programme is a rigorous course of study for motivated students. That said, prior academic success is less an indicator of ability to earn the diploma than are a student's determination to do his or her best, willingness to be organized in order to complete the work while leading a full, balanced life, and a strong commitment to learning in and beyond the classroom.

When considering students for admission to the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme at Celebration High School, the Admission Committee will review the following elements:

- Proficiency level on FL Standards Assessments (FSA) Reading
- Proficiency level on FL Standards Assessments (FSA) Math or Algebra EOC
- Teacher and Counselor Recommendations
- Academic Performance

Prerequisite Coursework:

Algebra 1 or Algebra 1 Honors are highly recommended to prepare students for the rigor of the high school courses sequences.
