Chorus Course Description:

Students develop skills in critical listening, vocal techniques, music literacy, and choral performance. Rehearsals focus on enhancing these skills and students' aesthetic engagement with music through a variety of high-quality three- and four- part choral literature, providing students with the means to learn how to reflect and use a combination of analytical, assessment, and problem-solving skills consistently to improve their own and others' performance.



Honors and AP Level Courses:

Students develop very advanced listening/aural skills and performance techniques, perform mastery of music and music theory through performance and completion of the AP Music Theory Exam to receive college credit.



Our students have performed at events such as the Amway Center's Orlando Magic Season Opening, Disney World's Candlelight Processional, Stetson's Men's Choir Festival, Florida All State Choir, University of Miami Frost School of Music, Fusion Fest at Dr. Philips Performing Arts Center, have been invited to perform at Carnegie Hall in NYC in 2021, and many others.
