Theatre 1

This course is designed for students with little or no theatre experience and promotes enjoyment and appreciation for all aspects of theatre. Classwork focuses on improvisation and creative dramatics. Beginning scene work are used to introduce students to acting and character development.

Theatre 2

This course is designed for students with a year of experience or more and promotes enjoyment and appreciation for all aspects of theatre through opportunities to build significantly on existing skills.

Theatre 3/4 Honors

This course is designed for students with significant experience in theatre and promotes depth of engagement and lifelong appreciation for theatre through a broad spectrum of teacher-assigned and self-directed study and performance. This class is required to participate in the Fall Play or Florida Thespians.

Musical Theatre

Students' course work focuses on, but is not limited to, acting, vocal performance, dance, non-dance movement, and staging, which transfer readily to performances in musicals and other venues. Music theatre students explore the unique staging and technical demands of musicals in contrast to non-musical plays. This class is required to perform in the Spring Musical.



Tohopekaliga Theatre Department produces yearly musicals and plays. They also compete in the Florida Thespian Competition and has made it to state for the pass three years.
