





Florida State University Admitted Students

AP, DE & your College Application

Competitive 4-year colleges will look for a minimum of 4-6 AP and/or DE classes on your academic record

They will also look for...

- Strong unweighted & weighted GPA
- Rigor of your course load
- High SAT/ACT scores
- Leadership & life experience part-time job and/or quality school involvement
- Project-oriented community service regular involvement in your community


AP, DE & your College Application

It's not about the acceptance, it's about succeeding once you're there

The basics of a high school diploma will not set you up for success at a college – whether you end up at Valencia College, Yale University or the University of Central Florida, you will only gain the skills you need to succeed academically in DE/AP coursework

The number 1 thing our graduates have reported as being most helpful in their college transition is having AP/DE coursework

The AP Advantage

- College-ready work without a college GPA
- Coursework is the same all over the world, so colleges know exactly what you learned and the rigor at which it was taught
- The AP class on your resume is what colleges will look for!

AP Capstone

- Internationally recognized by colleges
- An opportunity to earn a diploma in line with graduates from around the world
- Pass 4 AP tests, AP Seminar, and AP Research to earn the diploma
- You earn a certificate if you pass AP Seminar and AP Research, but not the 4 additional AP tests
- You get to pick the classes you take at an AP level
- Students who pass AP Seminar perform better on all other AP exams
- Equivalent program = IB



Dual Enrollment Opportunities

- DE allows students to earn high school and college credit simultaneously while also meeting graduation requirements
- DE courses are weighted the same as an AP course on GPA
- Begins college GPA (follows you beyond HS)
- Multiple DE opportunities depending on your academic goals:
 - Valencia College
 - University of Florida (online only)
 - University of Central Florida
 - oTech
- Each program has separate admission requirements
- District will start providing transportation Fall 2023*

Valencia Dual Enrollment

- Full-time and part-time options
- Courses offered in-person, online, or mixed mode
- Student can take a maximum of 12 credits (4 courses) per semester
- Students can earn Associate's (AA) degree through Valencia College
 - 60 credit hours
- Admission to Valencia DE leans heavily on PERT scores
 - Math: 114
 - Reading: 106
 - Writing: 103

- PERT will be offered on campus Feb 9 & 10 and again in March
 - Students can sign up to take through school website, DE newsletter or QR code in Guidance office
- PERT can also be taken at Valencia
- SAT/ACT Always select to send scores to Valencia

- Valencia PERT Resources/Online tutoring
- Valencia Student Support
