

Valencia College Dual Enrollment



Dual enrollment is an acceleration program which allows eligible students to pursue an advanced curriculum which provides students the opportunity to earn and college credit simultaneously. Osceola County School District covers the cost of tuition and books!



Valencia College Dual Enrollment Criteria

- 3.0 unweighted GPA
- Demonstrate college readiness in reading, writing and math by meeting testing score criteria below

Students can use the PERT, ACT, or SAT exams to qualify. Any combination of eligible scores (see below) will be accepted.

ACT: R 19, E 17, M 19/21
SAT: R 24, W 25, M 24/26.5

Any combination of eligible scores (see below) will be accepted.

Students interested in the dual enrollment program will need to take the PERT exam and secure the following scores: **PERT: Reading: 106, English: 103, Math: 114/123**

Parent/Guardian Consent is required.

Meet with your school counselor to review credits and to discuss your course selections.

Dual enrollment classes and grades are part of a student's permanent college record. Withdrawal from a dual enrollment course could adversely impact the student's ability to graduate from high school in a timely manner, have a negative impact on the college transcript, Bright Futures and future Financial Aid. Withdrawal from 2 courses makes you ineligible to take courses the following semester.



Dual Enrollment Scheduling Guidelines

- 4 classes at Valencia – full time, no classes at high school required
- 3 classes at Valencia – 1-3 classes at high school
- 2 classes at Valencia – 2-4 classes at high school
- 1 class at Valencia – 5 classes at high school
