A minimum of 24 credits are required for graduation. In addition, each student must complete 0.5 credits in an online course, as well as pass various state assessments.

AP & DE courses are weighted by one (1) point and Honors courses by half (0.5) point.

Grades are recorded on the transcript and GPA is calculated in January and June.
