

Males

 Wear a collared dress shirt or collared polo, dark colored pants, dark socks and black or brown dress shoes. Jeans are NOT ALLOWED. Shorts are NOT ALLOWED. Cargo pants are NOT ALLOWED.

FLIP-FLOPS, CASUAL SANDALS, SLIDES, OR TENNIS SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED

Females

- Dresses should be simply styled, lightweight dresses without high necklines. Dress collars should
 not show in the opening of the gown. Do not wear excessively full skirts. Your dress should not
 be longer than your graduation gown. No strapless dresses. No halter top or backless dresses.
 Shoulders and back should be covered. Neckline should be appropriate. Skirt length should be
 appropriate mid-thigh. If your dress or skirt is determined to be too short, you will be asked to
 return home and change.
- Jeans are NOT ALLOWED; Shorts are NOT ALLOWED; Leggings/Joggers are NOT ALLOWED; Pants must be black, navy, or brown dress pants.
- Dressy shoes are required. You may wear flats or dressy open-toed shoes. Sandals should have
 a strap on the back of the heel. Shoes should be black, white, or bone colored. No other colors
 allowed.

FLIP-FLOPS, CASUAL SANDALS, SLIDES, OR TENNIS SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED. All heels must be under 2" in height and have a closed heel or strap.

Cap Decorations

Please take into consideration the following rules when decorating your graduation cap. <u>Failure</u> to follow these rules will result in a replacement cap being given to you during commencement at your own cost!

- No offensive language, sayings, nicknames, pictures, or lyrics on cap
- No objects such as signs, stuffed animals, bells, flowers, lights, or any 3D object may rest on the cap.
- ALL decorations <u>MUST LAY FLAT</u> on the cap. Nothing can lay perpendicular thus allowing
 us to see the decoration beyond eye level.
- Your cap CANNOT make noise. No bells, horns, or anything that makes noise


It is appropriate to put the following on your cap.

- Recognize the university you will be attending.

Students, we highly suggest you trace your cap onto cardboard and decorate the cardboard. In case you make a mistake, you can start over with a new piece of cardboard. We will not furnish new caps if you mess yours up decorating. After you decorate it, stick it to your cap with double-sided tape or Velcro stickers. Velcro tape can be purchased at any fabric store, Target, Wal-Mart and throughout many CVS and Walgreens stores. Administration will reserve the right to disallow anything that is not considered appropriate for the commencement ceremony.
