Dear Students and Parents;

This letter is intended to provide an overview regarding AP exams for school year 2022/23. All this information and more can be found on the myap.collegeboard.org website.

EXAM DATES

- Exams will be given May 1-5, 8-12
- Makeup exams will be available only for limited situations where there is a verified conflict or emergency
- A table of the exam dates is provided at the end of this letter and is also available at https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/exam-administration-ordering-scores/exam-dates

EXAM FORMAT

- Traditional, full-length paper and pencil exams, administered in school, for most subjects
- The following subject exams will be administered digitally in school this year:
 - Ap English Language Composition
 - AP English Literature and Composition
 - AP Seminar
 - AP US History
 - AP World History
- In order to be successful on these Digital Exams, students will need to bring their laptop fully charged to school on the day of testing.
- All 2023 AP Exams will be full length and cover the full scope of course content described in the course and exam description (CED). (see your AP teacher for specific exam information for your AP course).
- All exams are scheduled to start at 8 a.m., 12 noon, and 2 p.m. (Physics C) local time. **Important**: bus riders please arrange transportation home when taking an afternoon exam.

EXAM SECURITY

You will be bound by the College Board Terms and Conditions as they exist on test day. You agree to go to cb.org/apexamterms prior to test day to review any updates. Updates will be clearly communicated at cb.org/apexamterms.

Prohibited items:

You **may not bring** prohibited items to the test. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Electronic equipment including phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any other type of electronic or communication device.
- School-owned and school-controlled digital recording devices are allowed only for the AP French, AP German, AP Italian, and AP Spanish Language and Culture Exams, and the AP Music Theory Exam.
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, pencils that are not No. 2, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils.
- Scratch paper: Students testing in-school are prohibited from bringing scratch paper to the AP Exam, but scratch paper will be provided.
- Watches that beep, make a noise, or have an alarm.
- Computers or calculators that are not approved.
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Ear plugs.
- Clothing or shoes with subject-related information.
- Food or drink.
- Clipboards.

PRIOR TO EXAM DAY

- All AP students will have an opportunity to take a full practice exam (Mock exam) prior to the official AP exam in May. Mock exams will be administered in a secure environment. (see your AP teacher for more details).
