GRADUATION PRACTICE

- <u>GRADUATION Practice: Monday May 19th 8am-10am (mandatory)</u>
- Graduation Walk to Thacker Ave. Elem. May 19th (optional) (immediately after practice 10am-12pm Cap&Gown required, truly amazing to do for the Thacker kids)
- Senior Awards Night, May 19th by Invitation Only, OHS Auditorium 5pm-8pm.
- GRADUATION Practice: Tuesday May 20th 8am-12 pm (mandatory)
- Location: Osceola High School Gym
- (10) Tickets will be given at practice.
- Must be in spirit shirt, polo, or senior hoodie, school-appropriate shorts or jeans.
- Graduates will be assigned a specific row and chair number so you must be on time to allow for location of seat and row.

GRADUATION

- GRADUATION: Wednesday May 21st at 5:30pm
- Location: Osceola Heritage Park currently
- Graduates will need to be there by 4:00pm dressed in their cap & gowns on the EAST SIDE of Osceola Heritage Park. Security wands, so NO CELLPHONES.
- Upon entering you will collect your diploma cover, graduation medallion, take your cap & gown photo before heading to your assigned row, check-in with the faculty row leader and then take your seat.
- Guests will enter through the front like normal. Security measures. Doors open 1 hour before start of ceremony.

REQUIREMENTS FOR DRESS CODE

- A dress of ANY color, cannot be longer than the gown sleeve, gown length, and neck of gown (suggestions: scooped neck, round neck, spaghetti strap type of gown) or blouse and long black pants.
- Any color dress shirt (long or short sleeved), any colored tie or bowtie, navy or black dress pants (NO JEANS)
- Flat Black Shoes (NO tennis or athletic shoes; NO HEELS you will be standing on a steep stairwell before the ceremony); sandals are acceptable with black straps
- Natural hair color; no facial piercings.
- Due to graduation caps being fitted, a suggestion for hair is to be smoothed out to fit properly.

REQUIREMENTS FOR STOLES AND CORDS

- Only approved Stoles and Cords are ALLOWED.
- The following organizations are the <u>ONLY</u> ones eligible for stoles & cords for the Class of 2025.
- <u>Stoles: NHS, National BETA, AVID, JROTC, 3DE (specific scenarios)</u>
- <u>Cords</u>: National BETA, AVID, Keyettes, AFJROTC, Top 25, Science Olympiad, Thespian Honor Society, LIA, BSA, Mu Alpha Theta Math Honor Society, Spanish Honor Society, Tri-M Music Honor Society, HOSA, Top 100 Admission, Senior Class Officer, Odyssey of the Mind, Eagle Scout, Kitty Hawk Honor Society, Military Enlistments (contract sent to College & Career Counselor)

REQUIREMENTS FOR DECORATING YOUR GRADUATION CAP

- The cap decoration CAN ONLY BE 2-D (flat to the cap top).
- Can only use fabric paint.
- No lights or garlands.
- School appropriate, language.
- <u>Must be approved before getting signature on May 20th. Microsoft Form</u> <u>Closes April 12th.</u>
- Decorated Cap <u>must be brought to graduation practice for final APPROVAL</u> by Graduation Coordinator Ms. Pettett. (1st day of practice May 19th)




