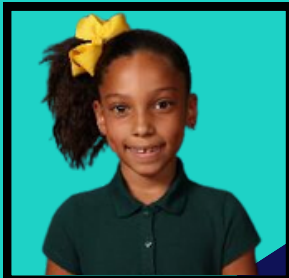

# Choice Options at a glance

As a “Choice District”, Osceola is at the forefront of the Choice movement. The Osceola School District operates under a controlled open enrollment (COE) plan. COE allows a parent from any school district in the state whose child is in good standing to enroll in any public school that has not reached capacity, subject to the maximum class size. Families with students entering Kindergarten through Grade 12 have the opportunity to choose from an array of theme-based curricula offerings that provide innovative and rigorous academic instruction by specially-trained teachers. These programs provide students with a pathway to post-secondary education and careers. Students may apply for one or two Choice or CTE programs with available space. Selection for placement is made in the spring of each year via a lottery. ## FOLLOW YOUR PATH

### CHOICE APPLICATION

- Applicants with an EXISTING Parent Portal account will find the Choice application under their child's information located in the left side column or by visiting [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) or [www.myosceolachoice.school](http://www.myosceolachoice.school) and clicking on the appropriate button.
- New or out-of-district applicants may create a Parent Portal account by visiting <https://osceolaschools.net/choice> or [www.myosceolachoice.school](http://www.myosceolachoice.school) and clicking the appropriate button.
- After creating the account, complete the Choice application by clicking on the appropriate button.
- Only one application per student may be submitted.
- A maximum of two Choice schools or program preferences per application may be selected.
- Applicants rank choices as first and second preferences.
- Programs may have a limited number of available seats, and not have any second choices assigned in the lottery.
- If the applicant has any siblings currently attending and will continue to attend the requested Choice school the following school year, this should be noted on the application. Siblings currently applying to the same Choice school should also be noted on the application.

- Late applications will be accepted after February 16, 2024. They may be considered only after all applicants in the wait pool have been assigned to their Choice School.

# Choice Options

## information

### LOTTERY SELECTION PROCESS

- The lottery will be conducted on February 7, 2024.
- If a program has more first-choice applicants than available seats, applicants will be assigned through the lottery selection process according to the following:
  - a. Dependent children of active-duty military personnel whose move resulted from military orders (documentation is required).
  - b. Children who have been relocated due to foster care placement in a different school zone.
  - c. Children who move due to a court-choice-ordered change in custody due to separation, divorce, or the serious illness or death of a custodial parent;
  - d. Siblings (to receive preferences, siblings must apply to the same Choice program or school that their sibling is currently attending and will be attending during the school year). Siblings are defined as brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, stepbrother, or stepsister living in the same household.
  - e. Children whose parent works for The School District of Osceola County;
  - f. Students who reside in the district; and,
  - g. Applicants from out of the district.

### POST LOTTERY

- All applicants will receive notification from the Educational Choices and Innovation Department via e-mail during the month of February 2024.
- All applicants may check their application status after February 15, 2024, by visiting our website and clicking on *Check Your Status*.
- All applicants must accept or decline their choice offer by March 1, 2024.
- Once an applicant is selected for one of his/her choices, he/she is immediately removed from the waiting list for the remaining program on the application.
- If an applicant declines their first assignment, he/she may opt for their second choice if there is capacity or return to his/her zoned school.
- Applicants assigned to their first choice assignment cannot choose to remain on the wait list for their second choice.
- If an applicant declines his/her second choice assignment, he/she may remain on the waiting list for their first choice. To be considered, eligibility criteria must be met for the first choice program.
- If an applicant is not selected for either one of his/her choices, the applicant is placed on the waiting list and may be assigned once a seat becomes available at the requested Choice school.
- If an applicant exits a Choice school program, voluntarily or involuntarily, he/she may exercise choice to another school by completing a new choice application or returning to his/her zoned school.
- All students are expected to follow the district's Code of Student Conduct.
- If an applicant is not selected to attend a Choice program before the start of the 2024-2025 school year, a new application may be submitted for the 2025-2026 school year.

### Eligibility Requirements for Applicants Applicants

- All applicants must meet Florida residency and age requirements.
- All applicants must be in good standing with the district.
- There are no elementary Choice program eligibility criteria, except for students requesting a Dual Language program in Grades 2 to 5.
- There are no elementary and middle school Choice program eligibility criteria for the IB Programme.
- Students not meeting eligibility criteria will be considered ineligible and will not be placed in the Choice lottery.

- Algebra I or Algebra I Honors and Spanish or French for high school credit are highly recommended
- Complete Additional Application for Admission

#### NeoCity Academy



Applicants will be ranked according to a scoring system.

- Entrance Exam
- Student Interview
- Teacher Recommendation
- Completion of Algebra I

#### Osceola Virtual School



- Proficiency level on FSA Reading and Math Assessment
- Grade of C or above in all courses
- High school students, a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above
- High school students must be on track to graduate
- Successfully promoted to the next grade

#### Osceola County School for the Arts (OCSA)



- Eligible Audition Score
- Positive Attendance Record
- Proficiency level on FSA Reading and Math Assessment

#### Professional and Technical High School (PATHS)



- 8th Grade Final GPA
- Proficiency level on middle school FSA Reading and Math Assessment
- Proficiency level in the Algebra 1 and Biology EOC (if applicable)
- Minimum of 2.0 GPA and current grades of C or higher in all core classes
- Students who do not have a 7th Grade FSA Reading score or who have taken Algebra 1 but do not have an Algebra 1 EOC score must contact oTECH to set up a time to take the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE).

Students must score at the current grade level in Math, Language, and Reading

- Complete Additional Application for Admission

#### Osceola Business Academy at Poinciana High



- Complete Additional Application for Admission
- 2.5 GPA (or minimum C grades in core subjects for incoming 9th graders without a GPA)
- Minimum level 2 on state assessments
- Minimal referrals/behaviors

#### SEAT AVAILABILITY

- The seat ranges listed for the number of available seats in schools are approximate; district growth and staffing needs may alter the final numbers.



# Choice Options information

## Transportation for Select Choice Programs

**Transportation Hubs** - The Choice programs eligible for transportation via hubs include:

1. Arts - Poinciana Academy of Fine Arts
2. STEM - Chestnut Elementary School for Science and Engineering, Discovery Intermediate, and Poinciana High School
3. Dual Language - Kissimmee Elementary School and Ventura Elementary School
4. International Baccalaureate (IB) - Thacker Avenue Elementary for International Studies and Parkway Middle School

Bus hub locations to the Choice schools may be limited and located significantly farther from the student's home than the transportation to the student's zone school.

Additional bus hub locations will not be created for students regardless of the student's proximity to the nearest stop.

**Transportation for Magnet and Specialized Programs** - Transportation will be provided to eligible students to:

1. Celebration High School: IB Program Only. Transportation will be provided to accepted IB applicants who live within the designated Celebration IB Zone. Refer to page 9 or [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) for the IB Transportation Zoning Map. Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent if the applicant does not live within the Celebration IB Zone.
2. Gateway High School: IB Program Only. Transportation will be provided to accepted IB applicants who live within the designated Gateway IB Zone. Refer to page 9 or [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) for the IB Transportation Zoning Map. Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent if the applicant does not live within the Gateway IB Zone.
3. NeoCity Academy
4. Professional and Technical High School (PATHS)
5. The Osceola County School for the Arts (OCSA)

**Other Transportation Information** - Transportation for students who live within two miles of the Choice school will be the responsibility of the parent.

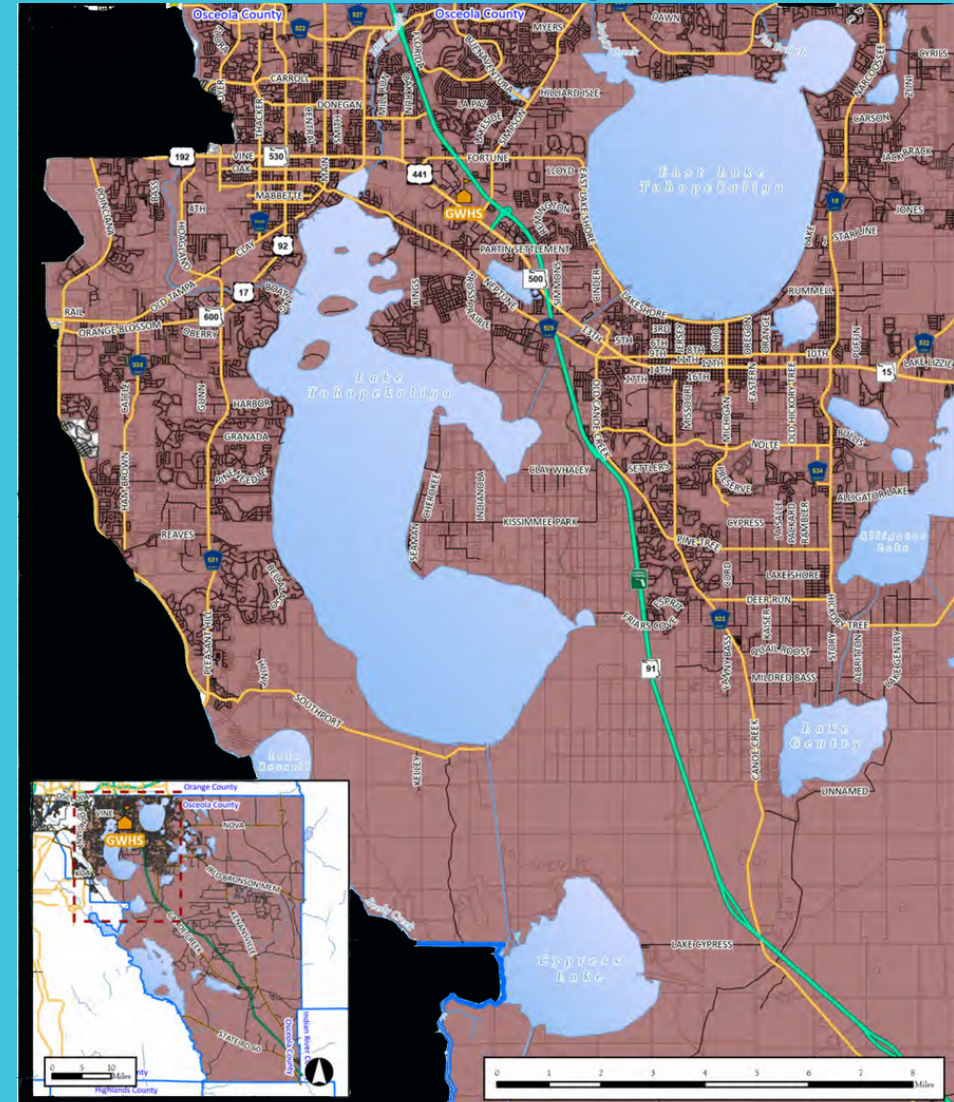
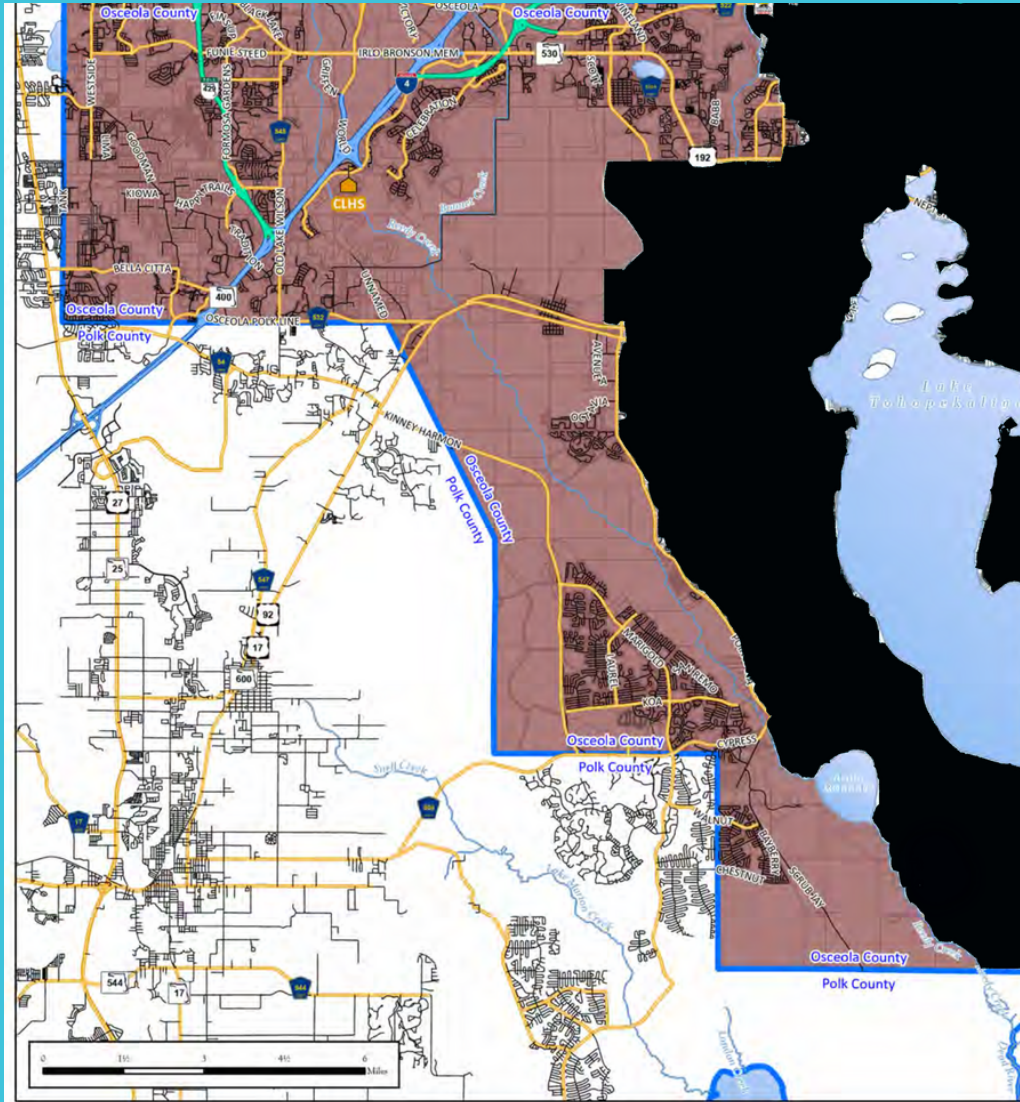

Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent if the applicant does not live within the Celebration IB Zone.

**Gateway High School - IB Program Only.** Transportation will be provided to accepted IB applicants who live within the designated Gateway IB Zone. Refer to [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) for the IB Transportation Zoning Map. Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent if the applicant does not live within the Gateway IB Zone.

# Choice Frequently asked questions

## **What is School Choice Florida?**

The Florida Legislature recognizes the value of an educational system that provides numerous and meaningful options for students and their parents. School Choice Florida promotes and encourages parental involvement and ensures students have access to a school that meets their needs. As a result of House Bill 7029, students can transfer to any school in Osceola County with open seats based on current capacity. Osceola is at the forefront of the Choice movement.

**Can I select my child's school for the 2024-2025 school year?** Yes. The Choice Application window will open from November 16, 2023, through January 26, 2024. Applying online is the most efficient way to submit your child's application. To apply visit, [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) or [www.myosceolachoice.school](http://www.myosceolachoice.school). Families may check the results by accessing the parent portal after February 15, 2024. Lottery results will be emailed in mid-February 2024.

**Can I apply after the deadline?** Yes. Late applications will be accepted after January 26, 2024; however, they will not be included in the February Choice lottery and may be considered only after all applicants in the wait pool have been assigned.

**What additional requirements are needed for my application?** Applicants requesting priority are required to submit the following documents, if applicable:

- Military Priority - Active duty orders
- Foster Care Priority - Placement documents
- Custody Priority - Court-ordered documents
- Siblings - Name and date of birth of the sibling attending the requested Choice School
- Employee Priority - Employee ID number, name of school/department, and position

An additional application for admission, testing, or audition is required for selected schools and programs.

**What is the difference between Choice Programs and Choice for Capacity?** Choice Programs offer families with students entering kindergarten through grade 12 the opportunity to choose from an array of theme-based curricula offerings at the elementary, middle, and high school levels that provide innovative and rigorous academic instruction by specially trained teachers. These programs provide students with a pathway to post-secondary education and careers. The choice for Capacity is seats available beyond the offered Choice Programs. If not interested in a Choice program, you may select Choice for Capacity on the Choice application.

**Is transportation provided to Choice students?** Transportation is the responsibility of the parent except for eligible programs.

**Do I have to reapply for Choice every year?** No. Choice approvals are valid until the highest grade level is offered at the Choice school. However, the application becomes null and void if the student withdraws from the Choice school.

**How can I check the status of my Choice application?** You may log in to your parent portal or visit [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) or [www.myosceolachoice.school](http://www.myosceolachoice.school) and click Check Your Status. If you are unable to check the status online, please email us at [choiceprogramapplication@osceolaschools.net](mailto:choiceprogramapplication@osceolaschools.net).

**Can I request Choice for the current school year?** Yes. Late Choice applications are received through the Spring of the current school year. If the school is currently at capacity, the application will be placed on a waiting list and considered once a seat becomes available. Applicants requesting a school with available seats will receive a Choice acceptance letter via email. To apply visit, [www.osceolaschools.net/choice](http://www.osceolaschools.net/choice) or [www.myosceolachoice.school](http://www.myosceolachoice.school).

**Do I have to apply every year if my student is not offered a Choice seat?** Yes. If a student is not offered a seat, a new Choice application is required for the following school year. The student will be assigned a new waitlist number during the Choice lottery process if the requested Choice school has more applicants than the number of seats available.

# MYTHBUSTERS

**MYTH:** Choice provides transportation.

**FACT:** Transportation is the responsibility of the parent, with the exception of certain eligible programs.

**MYTH:** I have to apply for choice every year.

**FACT:** Choice approvals are valid until the highest-grade level is offered at the Choice school. However, the application is canceled if the student withdraws from the Choice school.

**MYTH:** I can't apply for Choice after the deadline.

**FACT:** You are able to apply after the deadline. Late applications will be accepted after the application period; however, they will not be included in the February Choice lottery and may be considered only after all applicants in the wait pool have been assigned.

**MYTH:** I can complete a Choice application at my child's current school.

**FACT:** No. It is the parent/legal guardian's responsibility to guarantee that your child's application is submitted online or to the Educational Choices and Innovation Department by the deadline.

**MYTH:** I can submit one application for both my children.

**FACT:** A Choice application must be submitted for each child.

**MYTH:** I don't have to apply for Choice every year if my child is not offered a Choice seat.

**FACT:** If a student is not offered a seat, a new Choice application is required for the following school year. The student will be assigned a new waitlist number during the Choice lottery process if the requested Choice school has more applicants than the amount of seats available.

**MYTH:** I don't have to apply for Choice if my child is already in VPK/Pre-K at the school.

**FACT:** No. You will need to fill out a Choice application for kindergarten if the school is not your zoned school.

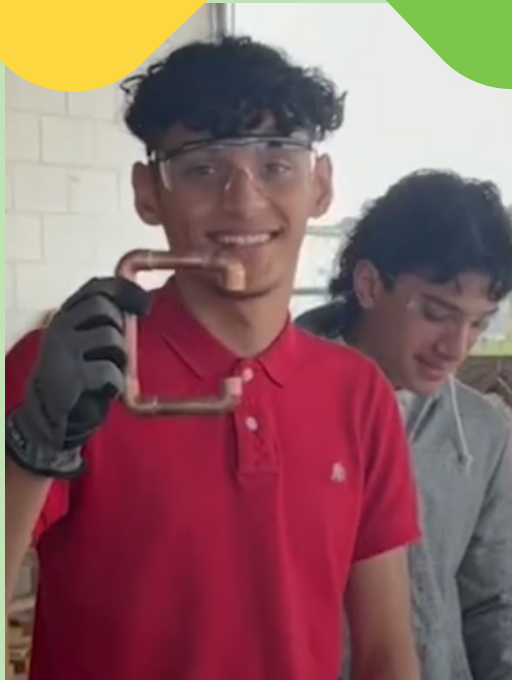

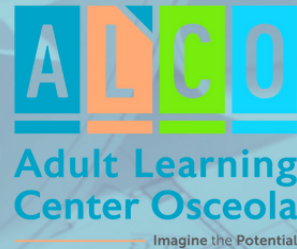
