HOLISTIC CURRICULUM

The IB curriculum is well-rounded and emphasizes academic rigor as well as non-academic experiences (including creative, active, and service experiences) which gives IB students a competitive edge when applying to colleges.

SKILLS FOR SUCCESS

The IB curriculum emphasizes academic, social, and personal skills that are necessary for students to succeed in high school and beyond.



COHORT MODEL

The IB Programme is structured according to a cohort model that ensures students take their core academic classes with other IB students. This allows students to develop meaningful relationships with their peers and instructors.

COLLEGE CREDIT

IB students can earn up to 45 college credits while still in high school. Many students enter as sophomores which allows them to take fewer classes each semester and/or graduate early.



COLLEGE ACCEPTANCES

IB students build competitive college resumes that highlight their academic and non-academic achievements (including creativity, activity, and service) which gives them a competitive edge above

FREE COLLEGE

Students who earn their IB Diplomas automatically qualify for Florida Academic Scholars Bright Futures scholarship that pays for 100% tuition at an in-state public college such as UF, FSU, USF, and UCF.
