IMPORTANT CHANGE – During the pandemic, we are requesting that parents drop off students at 9:05 if possible. This will minimize large gatherings in common areas while waiting for teachers to arrive and will help us maintain social distance for the students in the morning.

## Arrival and Departure Points

We want to ensure the safety and security of our students at all times. To ensure safety, access to campus will be limited to the following areas during arrival and dismissal times:

- **Greenbrier Street Loop** Bus drop off/pick up, including KinderCare and Community Presbyterian.
- Campus Street Loop Pride 1 Gate Car rider drop off/pick up for VPK through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and their older siblings.
- Campus Street Pride 4 Gate (by the school's Marquee) is open for walkers and bike riders (VPK through 8<sup>th</sup> grade) coming from the north and west side of campus.
- Gym Loop Car rider drop off/pick up for 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades only. Cars will be directed to pull up and drop off only. There will be no walker/bike rider access from the gym.
- Mulberry Gate Walkers and bike riders (1st through 8<sup>th</sup> grade) may enter through the Mulberry Gate (across from Founders Park).

Please note, for the safety of all, students utilizing the car rider loops must exit from the passenger side only. Students who must unload or load items from/into the trunk of the car should wait to pull all the way forward in the line before unloading/loading. This prevents the line from being delayed.

Please follow the directions of the staff on duty at each arrival/departure site. They are there to ensure student safety. Teachers will not be able to engage in conversations concerning your child as they
