As you get ready to enroll your child in kindergarten, please consider the School District of Osceola County your top choice to keep them thriving throughout their educational journey. Our school district offers every child an enriching learning experience while also providing a nurturing environment for your children to grow to their fullest potential. All elementary schools in our county offer unique extracurricular programming that aligns to the mission of each school. Students follow our STARS expectations. The STARS are our school-wide expectations for students to follow whether they are in the classroom, playground, hallways, or on the bus. The letters stand for the following: S-Safe at all Times, T- Take Responsibility, A- Active Listeners, R- Respect Yourself and Others, S- Strive for Success.

Several different sports are offered at Sunrise. We currently have a Cross Country team, Track Team, and Soccer Team.
