Student Parking

Student parking is a privilege. Priority is given first to graduating seniors, then juniors and sophomores who meet the eligibility requirements.

The completed School District of Osceola County Student Parking Permit application must be received along with 1.) A copy of the student's valid Florida license, 2.) copy of a valid insurance card listing the primary vehicle on the application, and 3.) copy of the valid registration for any vehicle the student wants to include under his/her parking permit.

The permit fee is \$40 and is non-refundable. Parking Fees support TKHS School Safety and Security. A student's parking permit may be revoked for disciplinary or administrative reasons at any time at the discretion of the principal or his designee. **Vehicles without a valid TKHS Parking Permit may be towed at the owner's expense!**

The hang tag should be displayed prominently on the vehicle. If it will not hang on the mirror it should be displayed on the dashboard on the driver's side of the vehicle. You may use the hang tag on any vehicle you included in your parking permit application.

General Parking Guidelines:

NO Back-in parking

Park only in designated spaces (paved and marked w space lines)

No Double Parking

DO NOT park along curbs, sidewalks or in reserved or designated spaces

Lock your vehicle and enter the campus as soon as you arrive

Be responsible and safe- **unsafe driving on OR off campus WILL result in revocation of your parking permit.**

Student parking is in rows 2, 3 and 4 of the "student" lot. Rows 1 (closest to the gym) and 5 (closest to the road) are reserved for school use
