You will need records of income earned in the year before when you will start school. You may also need your parent's income information records if you are a dependent student.

For the 2024-2025 school year (Fall/Spring Terms only), you will need financial information from 2022 and an FSA ID. For the FSA ID creation, please log on to: studentaid.gov (click on Create Account). For the FAFSA Completion, please log on to: studentaid.gov (click on Apply for Aid – Complete FAFSA)

Your 2022 W-2 and other records of money earned
Your (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2022 Federal Income Tax Return. IRS 1040 or 1040 EZ,
Foreign Tax Return, or Tax Return for Puerto Rico, Guam, America Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federal States of Micronesia, or Palau
Your Parents' <u>2022 Federal Income Tax Return</u> (1040) and <u>2022 W-2</u> (if you are a dependent student)
Your 2022 untaxed income records (If you are an independent student) Your Parents' 2022 untaxed income records (if you are a dependent student) Veterans non-education benefit records Child support received Worker's compensation
Your Parents' Date of Birth, Social Security Number, and Month/Year of Marriage, Divorce, Separation or Widowed
