
This document explains how to create a student Official SAT practice account on Khan Academy and successfully link with CollegeBoard to receive free personalized practice

Step 1: Visit www.khanacademy.org/sat


Step 2: Click "Sign up"




Step 3: Select "learner," enter your date of birth, and select SIGN UP WITH EMAIL

*if you have taken the SAT or PSAT/NMSQT, select A. If you have not, select B.

*If you are a 11th or 12th grader and have attended Osceola County schools in the past, you most likely have taken the PSAT and you should select A – ask your teacher to confirm.

*If you are a 9th grader, you will select B QUESTION 1 OF 2




