

## **Educational Leadership Requirement** for Certificate Renewal

House Bill 1537 section (3)(g) states: An applicant for renewal of a professional certificate in educational leadership from a Level I program under s. 1012.562(2) or Level II program under s. 1012.562(3), with a **beginning validity date of July 1, 2025**, or thereafter, must earn a minimum of 1 college credit or **20 inservice points** in Florida's educational Leadership standards, as established in rule by the State Board of Education.

The FDLRS/BEESS Portal - Offers online courses, at no cost to Florida educators, that may satisfy the requirement. <a href="www.flpla.org">www.flpla.org</a> (Starting March 1, 2024 – An External PD is NOT needed for FDLRS/BEESS courses.)
