

Reading Endorsement Options



FLDOE/UF Flamingo Project ~ Literacy Matrix ~ Micro-Credentials

- The Flamingo Literacy Matrix was created by the University of Florida in collaboration with Just Read, Florida! and the Florida Department of Education. It is a no cost option for Florida educators.
- The Flamingo Literacy Project is a competency-based, online professional development system designed to increase the capacity of educators to teach reading effectively, diagnose reading problems, and intervene appropriately using evidence-based methods. External PD is needed for inservice points.
- Complete the Literacy Micro-Credential for Competency 1.
- Continue with the Literacy Matrix to complete Competencies 2-5 for a full reading endorsement or a combination of competencies needed.

SDOC Professional Learning Reading Endorsement Courses

- For Comp 1 we suggest you do the Micro-Credential via UF, see above.
- We offer Comps 2 through 5, in the Fall, Winter and Summer semesters.
- Reading Endorsement courses are to be completed in sequence.
- Courses are offered online in Canvas with Live Meetings with a facilitator via TEAMS.
- Coursework includes job-embedded learning opportunities, case studies, readings, and assignments.
- Register in MyPGS.
- Fall course registration begins in MyPGS on the first teacher report back to work. Classes start the last week in August and run through December.
- Winter registration begins in mid-November in MyPGS. Classes start in January.
- Summer registration begins in mid-March in MyPGS. Classes start in late April and run through June.
- Courses are offered at no cost to SDOC district and eligible charter instructional personnel.

College/University Partners

- Florida colleges and universities began including reading courses and/or endorsements in their teacher preparation programs after 2006.
- Graduates are encouraged to apply directly to FLDOE to add the reading endorsement to their teaching certificate.
- Continuing education reading endorsement/certification courses are available from many university/college partners.
- Employees are responsible for any costs associated with this option.

- Complete your reading endorsement at your own pace from approved professional learning partners.

- Employees are responsible for any costs associated with professional learning partners and must complete the External PD process prior to participation for district approval.
