

Literacy Matrix

An Online Route to Reading Endorsement

You may be eligible to complete the **Flamingo Literacy Matrix for Reading Endorsement**; an online professional learning system created by the University of Florida's College of Education. The Literacy Matrix is designed to build on what you already know and increase knowledge and skills in key areas of reading to improve literacy outcomes for your students.

PARTICIPATION IN THE LITERACY MATRIX IS FREE TO ELIGIBLE INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL, SPONSORED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

You can choose to complete the entire Literacy Matrix or particular competencies you need to complete your Reading Endorsement. Each competency in Path A is timebound and six weeks in length. The accelerated timebound Path B is five weeks.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- A \$2,000 completion stipend is available for *eligible instructional personnel (public schools, including charters)
- Competency 5 requires that participants provide instruction to students who have reading needs. Participants are asked to assess, plan instruction, implement/submit a video of their instruction, post assess, and reflect.
- There are five terms in Path A and B. Participants can take up to 2 competencies each term.
