



Are you planning for retirement? - Learn more about Medicare!

As you may know, your School District partners with the Florida School Retiree Benefits Consortium (FSRBC) to provide Medicare-eligible retirees with access to high-quality Medical Medicare, Dental and Vision benefits, tailored especially for retirees age 65 or older. Once you are Medicare-eligible, FSRBC will expand your benefit options to include products and services tailored to your retiree needs (full list below). You can view FSRBC plan options available to your District as early as 3 months before your Medicare Eligibility Date.

AVAILABLE PLANS

Medicare Advantage with Prescription Drug Plans (MAPD)

- · Available in all districts
- · Similar to a traditional employer PPO or HMO Plan
- · Wide range of plan costs to fit your budget
- · Prescription Drug benefits included

Prescription Drug Plans (PDP)

- · Available in all districts
- · Provides coverage solely for Prescription Drugs
- · Can enroll in a PDP with Original Medicare or in conjunction with a Medicare Supplement

Medicare Supplement Plans (MedSupp)

- · Available in all districts
- · Additional medical coverage to supplement Medicare Parts A and B
- · Prescription drug benefits NOT included, highly recommended to also enroll in a Prescription Drug Plan (PDP)

Dental Plans

- · Available in all districts
- · Offered through Humana
- · Plan offerings include 3 PPO options and 2 HMO options
- · Preventive services covered

Vision Plans

- · Available in all districts
- · Offered through Humana
- · Two plan options offered
- · Low-cost copays for exams and materials

When you transition to FSRBC, these plans will take the place of the Active plans you have had access to through your District.
