BUS BULLETIN

Here Comes the Bus is a free application that gives parents and students the ability to track the location of their bus.

Information needed to get started:

- •Your child's student ID number
- •Your child's last name
- •School Code: 73760

The <u>Bus Bulletin</u> notification system is a free service used to notify schools, parents, and students when there are bus delays, substitute drivers, and/or schedule changes.
