



The Nita M. Lowey's 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC (Century Community Learning Center) is partnering with the School District of Osceola County's Summer Bridge Programs focusing on grades K- 4<sup>th</sup> grade. The Osceola School District will be offering a number of programs for eligible students this summer as acceleration opportunities.

Elementary school and early childhood education summer bridge 2021 opportunities include: Summer VPK, Summer PreK Camp, Welcome to Kindergarten Camp, Kindergarten Academy, First Grade Academy, Second Grade Academy, Third Grade Reading Summer Camp, STEAM Academy, Third Grade Academy, Fourth Grade Academy, Osceola Young Scholars Academy.

The 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC will serve as a supplementary program that can enhance state or local reform efforts to improve student academic achievement and to support their overall development. In particular, 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC funds will create and expand after-school programs that offer extended learning opportunities for children and their families.

The following sites are participating in 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC:

1. Central, Chestnut, Cypress, Deerwood (will begin June 7), Flora Ridge, Highlands, KOA, Pleasant Hill, Poinciana, Thacker, and Ventura
2. Two sites- Deerwood and Highlands will operate from 8:30am-12:30pm

During the week of June 14-17, 2021, Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade who qualify/were previously invited will automatically be enrolled into the Summer Bridge program from 8:30 am – 12:30 pm. From 12:00 pm – 12:30 pm, the students will go to lunch and from 12:30 pm-2:30 pm, these students will have the option of joining the 21<sup>st</sup>CCLC Program in the afternoon for clubs such as scrapbooking, culinary, arts, photography, coding, Lego clubs etc.,



The first week of camp will have the following students in attendance:

1. All incoming and outgoing 5<sup>th</sup> graders, along with 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders all day followed by K, 1, 2 in the afternoon

During the week of June 21- July 9, all grades K-5( qualified students) will be attending the program during the normal operating hours stated in the Site Profile Worksheet(SPW). **NORMAL SUMMER PROGRAM**

During the week of July 12-22, 2021, the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students who qualify/were previously invited will automatically be enrolled into the Summer Bridge program from 8:30 am – 12:00 pm. From 12:00 pm – 12:30 pm, the students will go to lunch and from 12:30 pm-2:30 pm, these students will have the option of joining the 21stCCLC Program in the afternoon for clubs such as scrapbooking, culinary, arts, photography, coding, Lego clubs etc.,

The last two weeks of camp will have the following students in attendance:

2. All incoming and outgoing 5<sup>th</sup> graders, along with grades K-2 all day followed by grades K-2.
