



RECOMMENDATIONS FOR AFTER-HOUR EMERGENCIES

In School Counseling services will occur during the school day and within the School District of Osceola County instructional calendar schedule. Services will not be provided during student holidays and breaks. If you feel these school-based services are not adequate to meet the needs of your child, please discuss this with your school social worker who can assist you in a referral for more intensive counseling services.

In emergency situations, please be aware that School District of Osceola County e-mail and voicemail are not private or confidential and may not be retrieved by your counselor after school hours.

If your child is threatening to hurt you or himself/herself and you do not sense immediate danger, please transport the child immediately to your local emergency room or your local Behavioral Health Center for immediate assessment.

If your child is threatening to hurt self or others and you sense immediate danger, please call 911 (Ask for Crisis Intervention Team (CIT Team)). For Mobile Crisis: Dial 211 or (407) 839-HELP or (407) 839-4357.
