School Update - Dr. Rasmussen:

 - ii. Subject teams now meet weekly to discuss progress and are able to better meet needs of all students.
 - iii. 5th-8th grade students all have AVID binders to improve organizational skills.
 - iv. Bellalago has an EBD (emotional behavior disorder) program for 5 students -1^{st} year. Going well so far.
