Car Rider Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Middle School shares the drop-off entrance with the Elementary School Car Loop at the South Entrance A for car riders. Please begin to arrive after 8:45 AM for drop-off. Drop-off begins with the bell at 8:50 AM when the gates open, and the gates close at 9:16 AM with the bell. Students must be in their 1st period class by 9:20 AM when the tardy bell rings. Late arrivals must report to the front office for tardy slip. School ends at 4:20 PM, so please arrive after 4:00 PM for afternoon pick-up. Pick-up gates close at approximately 4:40/3:40 (Wed).

A fee based program - Before the Bell, is offered through the district. Otherwise, walkers and bike riders will enter the front of campus beginning at 8:50 AM by the crossing guards at Entrance B. All car rider drop-off occurs through South Entrance A. Please plan accordingly.


