
Narcoossee Middle School

NCMS Elective Descriptions

AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination)

• By application only. AVID is a career and college readiness class that prepares you for high school and beyond. AVID helps you identify your interests, navigate your academics, and make a plan for a career that is best fit for you!

Band 1 (Beginning Band)

• The purpose of this course is to learn to play a musical instrument. No previous music knowledge is necessary, but practice is required. Students will perform in Winter and Spring Concerns.

Chorus 1

• Join a group of singers collaborating with melody and harmony as you sing together. Explore different types of music such as classical, pop, rock, jazz, and folk through song.

Orchestra

• Beginning musical class centered around string instruments.

Physical Education (PE)

• This course provides students with the opportunity to learn a variety of sports and sport related movements as well as health and fitness concepts.

- Design and Modeling
- Have you ever wanted to create a toy or a device to help people? Students use tools such as the design
 process, a dynamic mathematics software, a computer-aided design program, computer simulations, an
