GRADUATION

- **GRADUATION: Friday 5/23 at 6:00pm**
- **Location: Osceola Heritage Park**
- **Graduates will need to be there by 5:00pm** dressed in their cap & gowns on Cap Design must have prior approval! **NO CELLPHONES!**
- **You need to bring your Honor cords, medals, and stoles. NO HOMEMADE STOLES ARE PERMITTED** per district policy. Know your assigned seat number based on your art major and do not change seats.
- **GUESTS: Seating is first come/ first serve. Security measures. Doors open 1 hour before start of ceremony.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR DRESS CODE

- A dress of ANY color, cannot be longer than the gown sleeve, gown length, and neck of gown (suggestions: scooped neck, round neck, spaghetti strap type of gown) or blouse and long black pants.
- Any color dress shirt (long or short sleeved), any colored tie or bowtie, navy or black dress pants **(NO JEANS)**
- **Flat Shoes are recommended (NO tennis or athletic shoes);** A heel higher than 2 inches is NOT RECOMMENDED
- Due to graduation caps being fitted, a suggestion for hair is to be smoothed out to fit properly.

REQUIREMENTS FOR STOLES AND CORDS

- **Only approved Stoles and Cords are ALLOWED.**
- The following organizations are the ONLY ones eligible for stoles & cords for the Class of 2025.
- Stoles: VCC DE, Magna Cum Laude (4.0 to 4.199), Summa CL >4.2
- Cords: National Honor Society, Thespian Honor Society, LIA, BSA, Mu Alpha Theta Math Honor Society, Spanish Honor Society, Tri-M Music Honor Society, Top 100 Admission, EmpowHER, Pre-Vet, Military Enlistments (contract sent to College & Career Counselor)
- Any other organizations cannot use cords or stoles. If you have a question, then have your sponsor speak with Mr. Neal

REQUIREMENTS FOR DECORATING YOUR GRADUATION CAP

- The cap decoration CAN ONLY BE 2-D (flat to the cap top).
- Can only use fabric paint.
- No lights or garlands.
- School appropriate, language.
- Must be approved by first submitting the design through Forms by 5/13 and then you must bring finished cap to Mrs. Smith by May 21.






