FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the dates?

- Digital Learners: Wed. September 16, 2020 / 9:30am – 12:30pm & 1:00pm – 2:00pm
- Face to Face Students: Thurs. September 17, 2020 (grades 6 – 8) & Friday September 18, 2020 (grades 9 – 11). All pictures will be done before lunch.

Where do digital learners go to get their picture taken?

- South porch entrance of Expo Hall (parents stay in car). Watch video on social media for explicit directions
- Face to Face Students will be directed over announcements

Can digital students come on Thursday or Friday with the Face to Face students?

- No...guidelines for digital students have been set in place for Wednesday, the 16th.

Will digital learners be excused from class due to transporting back and forth from home for pictures?

- Yes, but keep in mind that taking advantage of picture day to be excused for all classes is not acceptable. Students will be responsible for any and all work assigned and need to communicate with their teachers.

Do students have to be in dress code?

- YES

Do I need to bring a picture day form?

- Yes. Picture Forms must be filled out for all students regardless if purchasing.

- There will be forms available at school, but we would like to avoid the exchange of materials as much as possible.

Do masks have to be worn?

- Masks will be worn until right before picture is taken and will be put back on once picture has been taken

Will there be a make up day?

- No. This is the only day to get pictures taken.
