Use of Weapon Detection Devices On Campus

QUESTION 01

Why was Osceola High selected as the first school in Osceola County for the weapon detection devices?

QUESTION 02

If an alert occurs after a student exits the device, school administration will conduct a more detailed search by utilizing handheld metal detection devices. The students' bookbags will also be searched by administration.

QUESTION 03

Are law enforcement officers involved in the screenings?

Law enforcement will not be involved in the screenings.

QUESTION 04

What if students are late to class as a result of the screening?

Students will receive an excused pass to class if they are late due to participating in the screening process.

QUESTION 05

What if students arrive on campus outside of the traditional school start time?

Students who arrive outside of the traditional school start time will participate in the same process. This process will occur as the student enters the Student Services office.
