- Create a TEAMS virtual class with your students
- Create a Remind group to keep your students/parents informed
- Keep in mind that most services and phone apps that require an email will use our old email (username@osceola.k12.fl.us). If that doesn't work, try the newer email address (first.last@osceolaschools.net). In either case, you will need to use your current AD password.

Ways to Distribute Files/Content:

- Microsoft TEAMS (either in files, chat, or as an assignment)
- Remind (blast links, files, or photos to people's cellphones or email)
- Email

Ways to Collect Files/Content:

- Microsoft TEAMS (either in FILES, chat, or as an assignment)
- OneDrive File Request link
- FORMS File Upload Question
- Email

Video or Virtual Presentation

- TEAMS Video (with desktop sharing available)
- STREAM Video (upload your video, share the link)
- PowerPoint Screen Record
- Whiteboard App
