2D Studio Art – Level 2 is an intermediate art class that reviews the elements of art and investigates the principles of design in depth. Students will also continue refining visual art knowledge learned in 2D Studio Art 1 such as **shading techniques**, **color theory**, **perspective**, **and facial proportions**. Additionally, students will learn concepts such as **composition**, **figure drawing**, **critique**, **research**, **and sequential art**. The Level 2 art class revolves heavily around the sketchbook and teaches students how important it is for artists to keep track of preliminary works and small projects. Many of the studies in Level 2 is designed to give students innovative ways of artistic expression on a wide range of media: such as pastel, colored pencil, watercolor, acrylic paint, collage, printmaking, etc. The skills learned in level 2 will help students succeed in an AP Art and Design class later in their high school art track. Homework usually consists of, but is not limited to, work that is not completed in class.

What is "P/P/WE" in the gradebook? This grade will appear in the gradebook starting at 80%, as your first grade every quarter.
