Drama

MIDDLE SCHOOL APPLICANTS

Monologues

 Prospective theater/drama student will memorize and perform two contrasting one-minute monologues provided by the department 1 week before the audition. Students who do not prepare the required audition material will not be considered.

Cold Read

- The student will also perform a "cold read" using a contemporary and classical monologue provided by the Department at the time of the audition. Participation in a group warm-up will also be required.
- All activities will be evaluated based on student's age, grade, and experience level.

HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS

Monologues

 Prospective theater/drama student will perform two prepared contrasting one-minute monologues from published plays. The type of character should be appropriate for the student's age and gender. Extreme characters such as King Lear, comic stereotypes, etc. are discouraged. Students who do not prepare the required audition material will not be considered.

Cold Read

- The student will also perform a "cold read" using a contemporary and classical monologue provided by the Department at the time of the audition. Participation in a group warm-up will also be required.
- Applicants will also have an interview with a faculty member.
- All activities will be evaluated based on student's age, grade, and experience level.
