- Laptop distribution date TBD: We are currently waiting on the laptop cases to arrive. As soon as they arrive, we will share a date/time for laptop distribution. Laptop distribution will take place after school in the bus loop. More information/directions will be forthcoming. Students will receive an 11 in lightweight Dell laptop, a charger for the laptop, and a laptop case. (hotspots are limited. Submit your request by returning this letter ASAP).

Student will need to bring their provided laptop back to school every day, **fully charged** ready for class. The laptops will be filtered and monitored during school and home use. The students will receive a laptop case as soon as soon as they arrive. Students are expected to ensure that all devices checked out to them are stored securely in their bag to prevent devices from being damaged.

Students will bring two forms home. The first form is this letter. It must be filled out with the student's name and ID#. Please check all appropriate options. Students must return this letter to their science teacher. The second form is the KMS 1:1 Info. Handout/End of Year Check-in form with the care tips, responsibilities, and service fees for repairs on the back. Please keep this form till the end of year.
