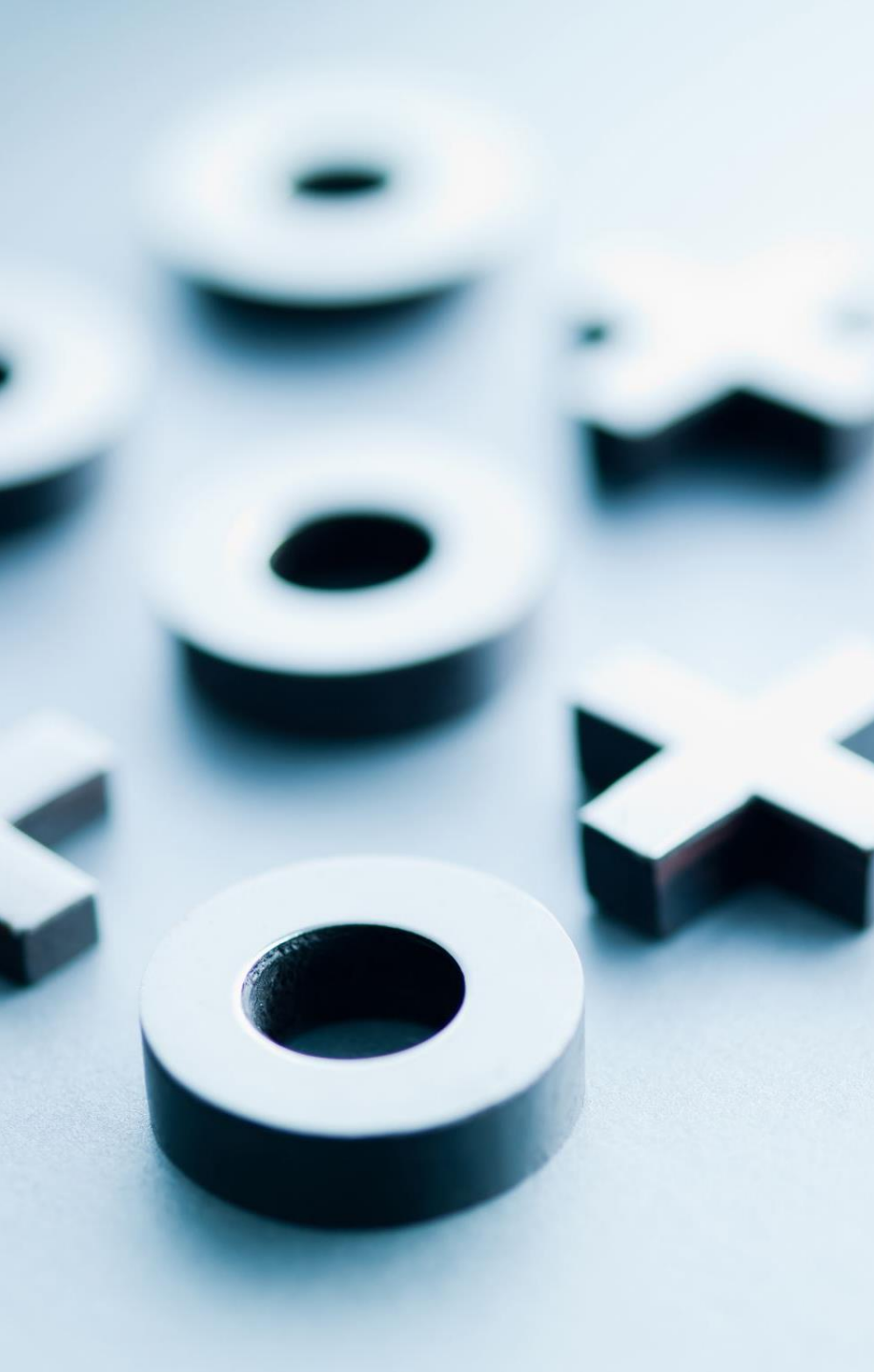

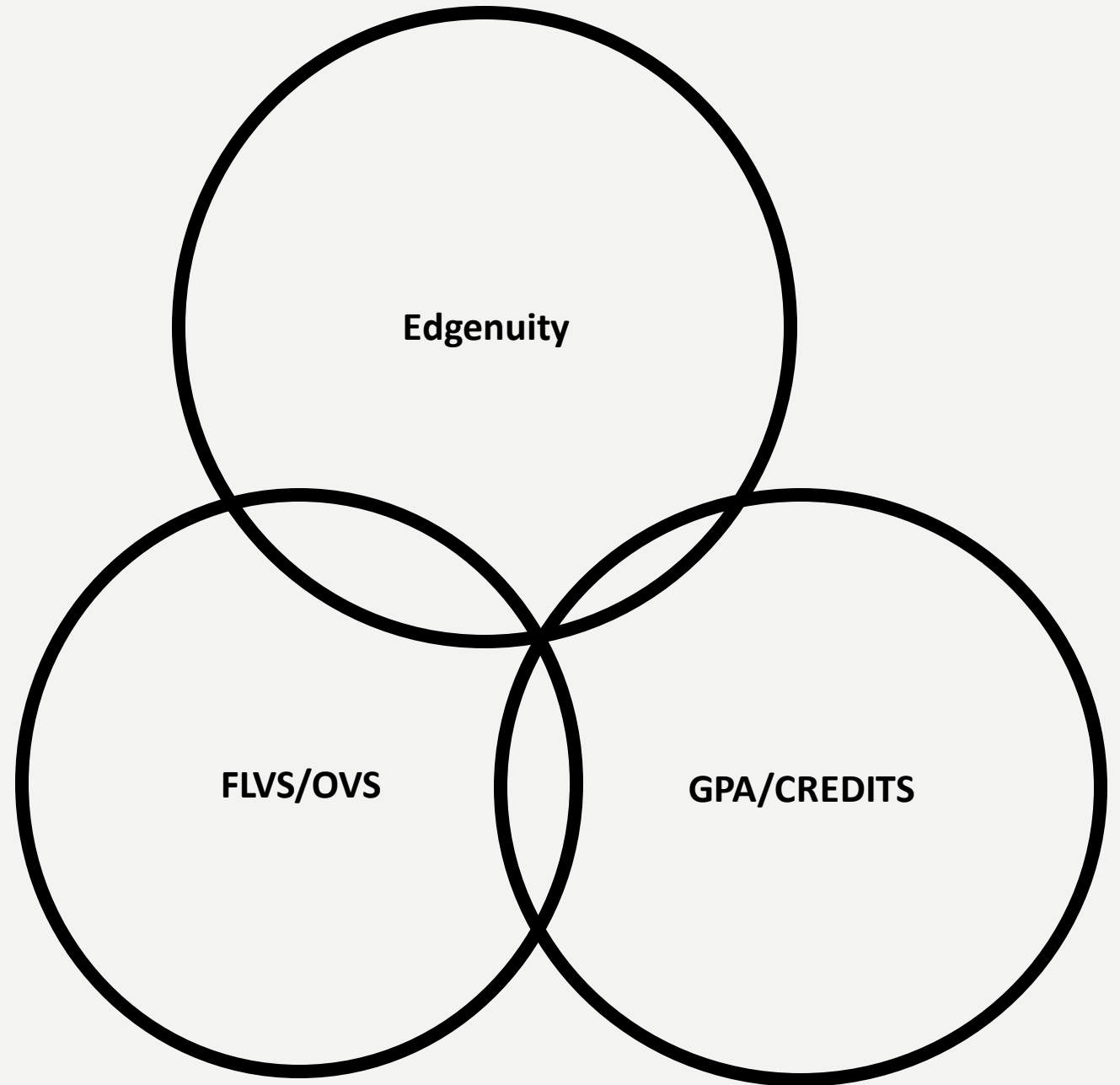

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

Dress Code Guidelines



Tops:

- Collared polo or button down shirt (solid color)
- Colors - white, navy blue, yellow, royal blue, black
- NO DESIGNS, STRIPES, SHEER, etc.
- School athletic, club sponsored T-shirts allowed
- College T-shirts are allowed on Tuesdays
- NO Blood Drive Shirts

Ex. Any rips, any size,
any place
NOT ALLOWED!

Bottoms:

- Blue or black denim jeans; Black, navy blue, Khaki pants
- Shorts must extend to mid-thigh
- Must be worn at the natural waistline (all students)
- Absolutely NO:
 - Leggings, sweatpants, joggers, yoga pants, dresses, gym shorts, track pants, pajama pants, NO SHOWING OF SKIN while wearing ripped or frayed jeans



Shoes:

- Sneakers, flats, boots
 - Sandals
- (cannot interfere with class policies)
- NO SLIPPERS
