Instructor students must possess a General Instructor Certification or be eligible for and apply for the General Instructor Certification at the same time as the High Liability Instructor Certification.</p> <p>Upon completion of the course of instruction, students must demonstrate the appropriate practical skill associated with first aid training and pass a written examination with a minimum score of 85%. <b>Students must attain approved CPR Instructor certification before applying to CJSTC for First Aid Instructor status.</b></p>
<b><u>PARTICIPANTS/ SEATING</u></b>	<b>This class is limited to 18 participants. Priority seating goes to Osceola County Law Enforcement and Instructors with the Criminal Justice Academy of Osceola.</b>

<b><u>MATERIALS</u></b>	1000 rounds of ammo, weapon, duty gear, vest, safety glasses, ear protection, and flashlight.

<b><u>COURSE DESCRIPTION</u></b>	This course is a high liability course that has been significantly modified from the previous instruction. The new techniques and requirements were developed based on significant data related to past deadly force encounters. Substantial time will be allocated to "teach back" exercises and diagnosing performance deficiencies. Participants will be required to successfully meet the following: Achieve a score of no less than 85% on the written end-of-course examination; Demonstrate proficiency skills as required in CJSTC rules; Firearms instructor students must demonstrate all handgun proficiency skills as specified in the course and complete a series of Active Threat/Shooter drills.
