14. \_\_\_ I stay engaged during class and have strong note-taking skills.

**Scores of 14-42:** Scores in this range may indicate that you do not possess the skills required for success in dual enrollment at the time.

**Scores of 43-55:** Scores in this range indicate you might be ready for dual enrollment, however, some areas require improvement.

**Scores of 56-70:** Scores in this range may indicate you have the skills to be a successful dual enrollment candidate.
