

General Dress Code Policy Requirements

Appropriate Sizes: Students shall wear clothing of appropriate size as determined by the principal or designee exercising his or her judgment. The size of shirts and pants shall be appropriate to the student's body size and shall not be unduly oversized or undersized.

Shirts: Shirts shall be tucked into the waistband of the pants or skirts. The four acceptable colors of collared polo shirts are **white, navy, royal blue, and burnt orange.**

Pants: Pants and shorts with belt loops shall be worn with a belt that is properly fastened. Pants and shorts shall be worn so that the waistband is worn at the waist. Pants or shorts can be blue or khaki. **Athletic shorts including spandex style "bicycle" shorts, cut off jeans, pants or shorts with frays or teats, cut-off sweat pants, short-shorts, running shorts, and see-through boxer-type shorts , form fitting clothing, and see through boxer type shorts ARE NOT PERMITTED!!**

Shoes: High school students may wear sandals provided that they do not interfere with the safety and welfare of the student. House slippers are NOT PERMITTED.

Under Garments: T-shirts and camisoles worn under polo shirts must be one of the four main colors—white, navy, royal blue, and burnt orange.

Unacceptable attire:

Students may not have any visible body piercings, except for earrings on the ears; all body piercing jewelry/items must be removed and not concealed.

Students may not have any hair style or color that is extremely garish or distracting for other students.

All dress code violations fall under the jurisdiction and judgment of administration. If any clothing is deemed disruptive, administration has the authority to make adjustments as deemed.
