What is New? THE AVID ELECTIVE

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) is a college and career readiness program where student's strengthen their academic skills via a model of WICOR (Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization and Reading). The AVID elective strives to close the opportunity gap to prepare all students for college, careers, and life. Many AVID students will become the first in their family history to enter college. By shifting to a more equitable, student-centered approach, students' lives are changed! The AVID elective ensures that students get the support needed to believe in themselves, handle the most rigorous classes, and understand the opportunities available to them. Students are engaged as critical thinkers and create content mastery through inquiry and collaboration. Note-taking, study, and organizational skills, are all important concepts that are taught, learned, and perfected for future success.

Starting the 2021-2022 school year all elementary schools will be using the AVID strategies across their campus and all middle, multilevel and high schools are offering the AVID elective. Eligible students will be required to complete the AVID Elective Application, obtain a teacher recommendation, participate in an interview, maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and an acceptable attendance and behavior record.
