## Did You Know ...

The Osceola School District offers a pathway for International Baccalaureate education for students in grades K-12. Students interested in IB may begin their IB Education at Thacker Avenue Elementary School for International Studies with the Primary Years Program and then transition to the Middle Years Program at Parkway Middle School. During eighth grade, students will have the opportunity to apply for the Diploma Program at either Gateway High School or Celebration High School. Students who graduate with an IB Diploma are more likely to be accepted to a top tier university as the IB courses are widely recognized by the world's leading universities. Some universities offer scholarships and advanced placement for IB students. Currently there is recognition in over 100 countries and by over 2,000 universities.
