OPTIONS AT A GLANCE

As a "Choice District", Osceola is at the forefront of the Choice movement. The Osceola School District operates under a controlled open enrollment (COE) plan. COE allows a parent from any school district in the state whose child is in good standing to enroll in any public school that has not reached capacity, subject to the maximum class size. Families with students entering Kindergarten through Grade 12 have the opportunity to choose from an array of theme-based curricula offerings that provide innovative and rigorous academic instruction by specially-trained teachers. These programs provide students with a pathway to post-secondary education and careers. Students may apply for one or two Choice or CTE programs with available space. Selection for placement is made in the spring of each year via a lottery. For more information, visit: https://www.osceolaschools.net/choice or www.myosceolachoice.school.



Choice for Capacity:

There are seats available beyond the offered Choice programs. If you are not interested in a Choice program, you may select Choice for Capacity on the Choice application.

Dual Enrollment Information:

- Dual enrollment courses may be offered on and off campus.
- Contact the school of choice for more information.

Advanced Placement Information

• All high schools listed in this booklet offer students the opportunity to apply for advanced placement courses.

• All schools listed in this booklet offer a gifted program for eligible students.

CHOICE APPLICATION

- Applicants with an EXISTING Parent Portal account will find the Choice application under their child information located in the left side column or visit <u>www.osceolaschools.net/choice</u> or <u>www.myosceolachoice.school</u> and click on the gear.
- New or out-of-district applicants may create a Parent Portal account by visiting <u>https://osceolaschools.net/choice</u> or <u>www.myosceolachoice.school</u> and clicking on the gear. After creating your account, you'll complete the Choice application by clicking on the gear.
- · Only one application per student may be submitted.
- · A maximum of two Choice schools or program preferences per application may be selected.
- · Applicants rank choices as first and second preferences.
- · Programs may have limited number of available seats, and not have any second choices assigned in the lottery.
- If the applicant has any siblings currently attending and will continue to attend the requested Choice school the following school year, this should be noted on the application. Siblings currently applying to the same Choice school should also be noted on the application.

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANTS

- All applicants must meet Florida residency and age requirements.
- All applicants must be in good standing with the district.
- There are no elementary Choice program eligibility criteria, except for students requesting a Dual Language program in Grades 2 to 5.
- There are no elementary and middle school Choice program eligibility criteria for the IB Programme.
- Students not meeting eligibility criteria will be considered ineligible, and will not be placed in the Choice lottery.

Slingshot

Slingshot

Slingshot is an Osceola County program with the goal of providing an opportunity to students that in elementary school needed additional support and repeated one or two school years. This program looks for students that after the support the elementary school provided are on, or close to, grade level and are ready to complete two years of curriculum in one school year. The eligibility criteria are as follows:

1. The student should have been retained once or twice in elementary school.

2. The student should be working on, or near, grade level ability in Reading and Math.

3. The student should have and maintain a good attendance record.

4. The student should demonstrate individual determination and self-motivation to successfully complete this fast-paced rigorous program.

The program is offered at Discovery Intermediate and Parkway Middle School. Transportation options are available for eligible students via a hub system.

Choice OPTIONS INFORMATION

LOTTERY SELECTION PROCESS

The lottery will be conducted February 8, 2022.

If a program has more first choice applicants than available seats, applicants will be assigned through the lottery selection process
according to the following:

- 1. Dependent children of active duty military personnel whose move resulted from military orders (documentation is required);
- 2. Children who have been relocated due to foster care placement in a different school zone;

3. Children who move due to a court-ordered change in custody due to separation, divorce, or the serious illness or death of a custodial parent;

4. Siblings (to receive preferences, siblings must apply to the same Choice program or school that their sibling is currently attending and will be attending during the school year). Siblings are defined as brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, stepbrother, or stepsister living in the same household.

- 5. Children whose parent works for The School District of Osceola County;
- 6. Students who reside in the district; and,
- 7. Applicants from out of district.

POST LOTTERY

• All applicants will receive notification from the Educational Choices and Innovation Department via e-mail during the month of February 2022.

- · All applicants may check their application status after February 15, 2022 by visiting our website and clicking on Check Your Status
- All applicants must accept or decline their choice offer by March 1, 2022.
- Once a student is selected for one of his/her choices, he/she is immediately removed from the waiting list for the remaining program on the application.
- If a student declines their first assignment, he/she may opt for their second choice if there is capacity or return to his/her zoned school.
- · Students assigned to their first choice assignment cannot choose to remain on the wait list for their second choice.
- If a student declines his/her second choice assignment, he/she may remain on the waiting list for their first choice. To be considered, eligibility criteria must be met for the first choice program.
- If an applicant is not be selected for either one of his/her choices, the applicant is placed on the waiting list and may be assigned once a seat becomes available at the requested Choice school.

• If a student exits a Choice school program, voluntarily or involuntarily, he/she may exercise choice to another school by completing a new choice application or return to his/her zoned school.

- All students are expected to follow the district's Code of Student Conduct.
- If a student is not selected to attend a Choice program prior to the start of the 2022-2023 school year, a new application may be submitted for the 2023-2024 school year.

SEAT AVAILABILITY

• Seat ranges listed for number of available seats in schools are approximate; district growth and staffing needs may alter final numbers.

TRANSPORTATION

- The Choice programs eligible for transportation via hubs include:
 - 1. Arts Poinciana Academy of Fine Arts
 - 2. STEM Chestnut Elementary School for Science and Engineering, Discovery Intermediate, and Poinciana High School
 - 3. Dual Language Kissimmee Elementary School and Ventura Elementary School
 - 4. International Baccalaureate (IB) Thacker Avenue Elementary for International Studies and Parkway Middle School
- Bus hub locations to the Choice schools may be limited and located significantly farther from the student's home than the transportation to the student's zone school.
- · Additional bus hub locations will not be created for students regardless of the student's proximity to the nearest stop.
- Transportation for students who live within two miles of the Choice school will be the responsibility of the parent.
- · All information related to transportation will be provided by the Choice school, if applicable.

 - 1. Celebration High School: IB Programme Only
 - 2. Gateway High School: IB Programme Only

- 4. Professional and Technical High School (PATHS)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is School Choice Florida? The Florida Legislature recognizes the value of an educational system that provides numerous and meaningful options for students and their parents. School Choice Florida promotes and encourages parental involvement and ensure students have access to a school that meets their needs. As a result of House Bill 7029, students are able to transfer to any school in Osceola County with open seats based on current capacity. Osceola is at the forefront of the Choice movement.

Can I select my child's school for the 2022-2023 school year? Yes. The Choice Application window will open on November 18, 2021 through January 28, 2022. Applying online is the most efficient way to submit your child's application. To apply visit, www.osceolaschools.net/choice_or_www.myosceolachoice.school_. Families may check the results by accessing the parent portal after February 15, 2022. Lottery results will be emailed mid-February 2022.

Can I apply after the deadline? Yes. Late applications will be accepted after February 21, 2022; however, they will not be included in the February Choice lottery, and may be considered only after all applicants in the wait pool have been assigned.

What additional requirements are needed for my application? Applicants requesting priority are required to submit the following documents:

- Military Priority - Active duty orders

Choice

- Foster Care Priority Placement documents
- Custody Priority Court-ordered documents
- Siblings Name and date of birth of the sibling attending the requested Choice school
- Employee Priority Employee ID number, name of school/department and position

An additional application for admission, testing or audition is required for selected schools and programs.

What is the difference between Choice Programs and Choice for Capacity? Choice Programs offer families with students entering kindergarten through grade 12 the opportunity to choose from an array of theme-based curricula offerings at the elementary, middle, and high school levels that provide innovative and rigorous academic instruction by specially trained teachers. These programs provide students with a pathway to post-secondary education and careers. Choice for Capacity are seats available beyond the offered Choice Programs. If not interested in a Choice program, you may select Choice for Capacity on the Choice application.

Is transportation provided to Choice students ? Transportation is the responsibility of the parent except for eligible programs.

Do I have to reapply for Choice every year? No. Choice approvals are valid until the highest grade level offered at the Choice school. However, the application becomes null and void if the student withdraws from the Choice school.

How can I check the status of my Choice application? You may log in to your parent portal or visit <u>www.osceolaschools.net/choice</u> or <u>www.myosceolachoice.school</u> and click *Check Your Status*. If you are unable to check the status online, please email us at <u>choiceprogramapplication@osceolaschools.net</u>.

Can I request Choice for the current school year? Yes. Late Choice applications are received through the Spring of the current school year. If the school is currently at capacity, the application will be placed on a waiting list and considered once a seat becomes available. Applicants requesting a school with available seats will receive a Choice acceptance letter via email. To apply visit, www.myosceolaschools.net/choice or www.myosceolachoice.school.

Do I have to apply every year if my student is not offered a Choice seat? Yes. If a student is not offered a seat, a new Choice application is required for the following school year. The student will be assigned a new waitlist number during the Choice lottery process if the requested Choice school has more applicants than the amount of seats available.
