 - 1 Safety School (Backup school you can 100% be admitted, like Valencia)

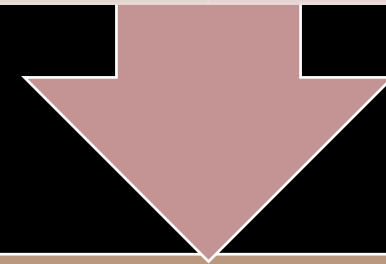
You can add reach schools—colleges that you would love to attend, but admissions or finances might be a stretch.

Weird yet Important terms for Application Dates

Application types:

- Early Decision—Apply to one school and it is binding for acceptance
- Early Action—non-binding acceptance to a school before the regular deadline
- Restrictive Early Action—same as early action, but you cannot apply to any early decision schools.
- Regular Decision—Deadline to apply

Update your resume and bulb portfolio

Consider who you would like to name as your recommenders (2 NeoCity staff and a community member is a good idea)

Update raise.me (we started this in 9th grade—micro scholarships)

4

Look for scholarships on collegeboard.org, fastweb, Xello/scholarhips.

5

Sign up for [ACT/SAT](#) for a higher super-score if needed

On September 1st

At NeoCity we will set up:

Common Application: One application that links to several colleges

SARR: Self reported grades for colleges to view

We will link your Xello account to the Common App

Some colleges use other applications. No problem, we can set those up too.

These Applications will ask for your recommenders, make sure you have talked to them/emailed your resume and have their correct contact info. They will be completing rating scales and answering questions about you.

October 15th

Have all applications completed and ready to submit.

Each of you are choosing different schools and we may wait to submit certain applications. I will be working with you on submit dates. But be ready by Oct. 15th.

Other Dates:

October 1st

- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) When we get closer, I will send info out to your parents. They will need their tax returns to fill this out. Most colleges require the FAFSA regardless of income.
- Bright Futures Application opens: We will be filling out the application as a school. No essay, just info about you. You don't need to have all of the requirements completed until you graduate, but we will fill it out in October. There are also several other state scholarships attached to that application.

May 1st College decision deadline. National day to announce and commit to your College.

To be MOST prepared

Over the
summer:

- You can start filling out the [Common App](#) and review and start the [personal statements](#)
- Start your [SARR](#) (wait until you see full credits in focus from 11th grade)
- Read/research College Application books/blogs/videos/etc.
