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Course Description:

This course is a continuance of the Spanish language. The prerequisite to this course is Pre-IB Spanish 1. We will study grammatical structures of the language as well as culture. There will be an emphasis on Spanish vocabulary and verb conjugations. There will be numerous opportunities for oral practice as well as writing and reading in Spanish. Students will need to be prepared to make oral presentations from time to time in the target language.

Required Materials:

1 Composition Notebook (Cuaderno de Escribir)

Small binder (or a larger binder shared with other classes with a section for Spanish)

Pen or Pencil
