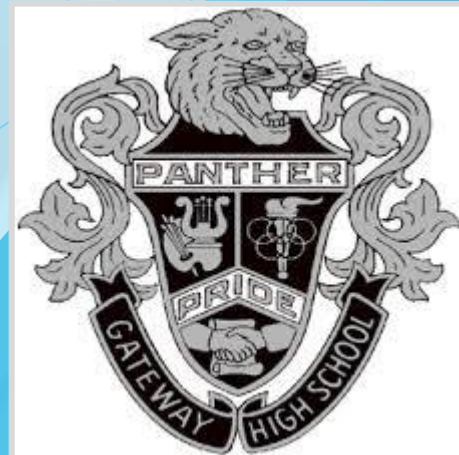

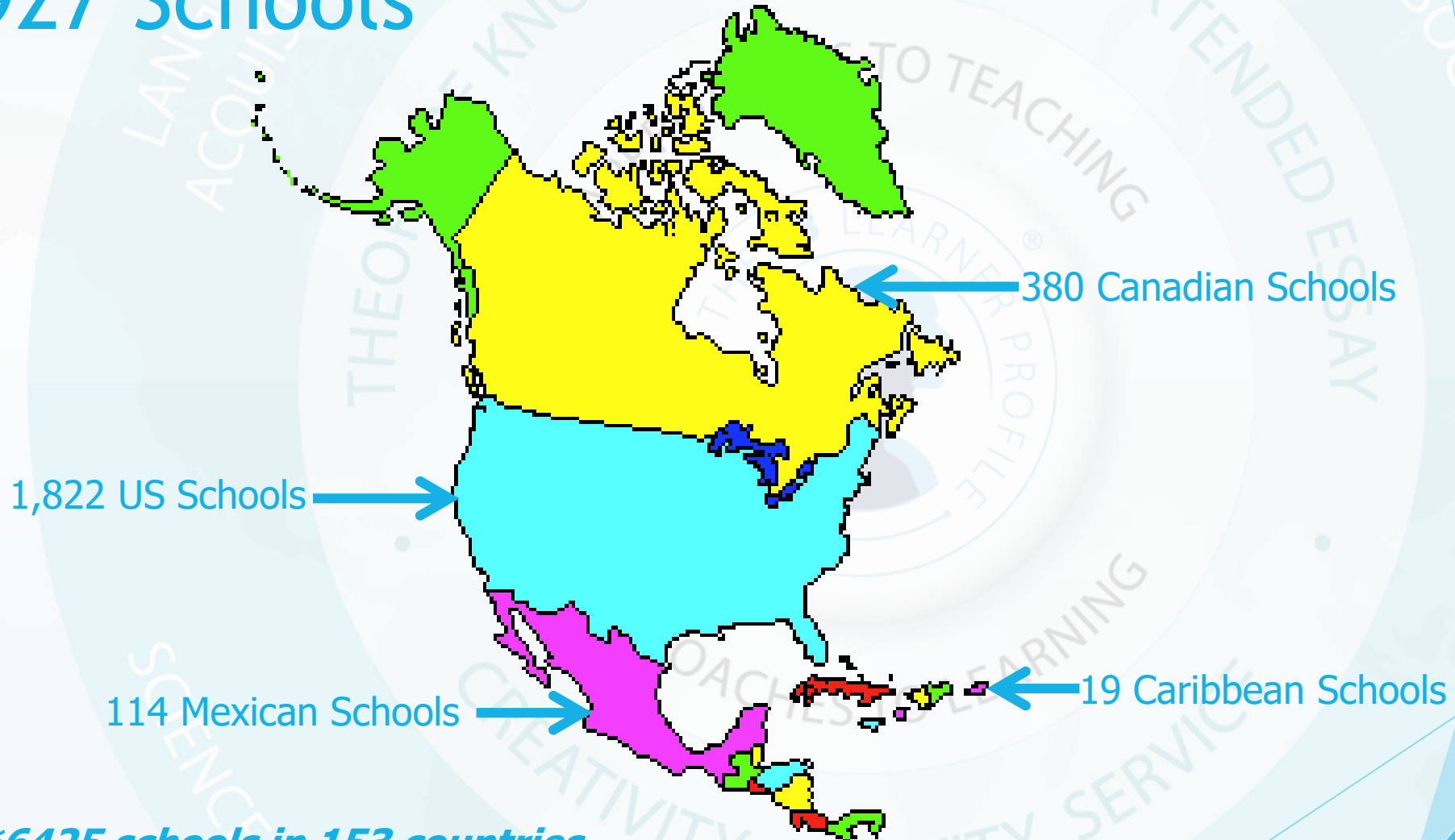

****More than 1,250,000 students world wide***

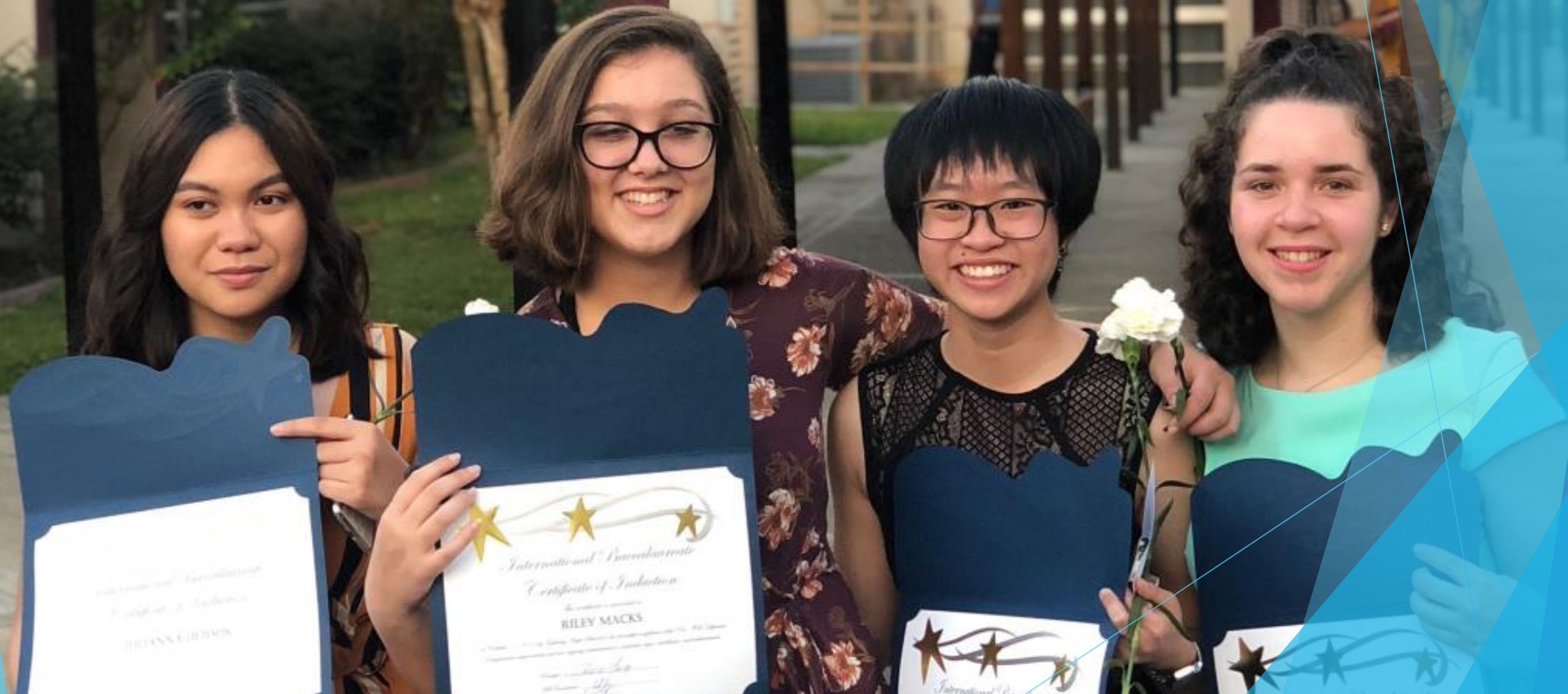

Benefits of IB

- ▶ **Scholarship Opportunities**
 - ▶ Full Bright Futures Scholarship with IB Diploma
 - ▶ On average, each graduating IB class earns over \$5 million in scholarships
- ▶ **Awarded College Credits based on Performance**
 - ▶ On average, each IB student receives 24-30 College credits
- ▶ **Helps Build College Application**
- ▶ **Students in top of their class**
- ▶ **Develops academic resumes for college applications**
- ▶ **Acceptance into most prestigious universities**

Benefits of IB

- ▶ Assessment/Evaluation is holistic
 - ▶ Not just one end-of-the-year exam
 - ▶ Written & oral components to target multiple student strengths
 - ▶ Assessments are short *and* occur over multiple days
 - ▶ Global standardization
- ▶ Exceptionally *well-rounded* education
 - ▶ Students are not pigeon-holed into one subject group or type of learning
 - ▶ Students learn the interdependence of all subjects

Benefits of IB (Core)

- ▶ Creates experiential learning opportunities outside of the classroom
- ▶ IB core education includes
 - ▶ *Extended Essay*
 - ▶ *Theory of Knowledge*
 - ▶ *Creativity, Action, Service (CAS)*

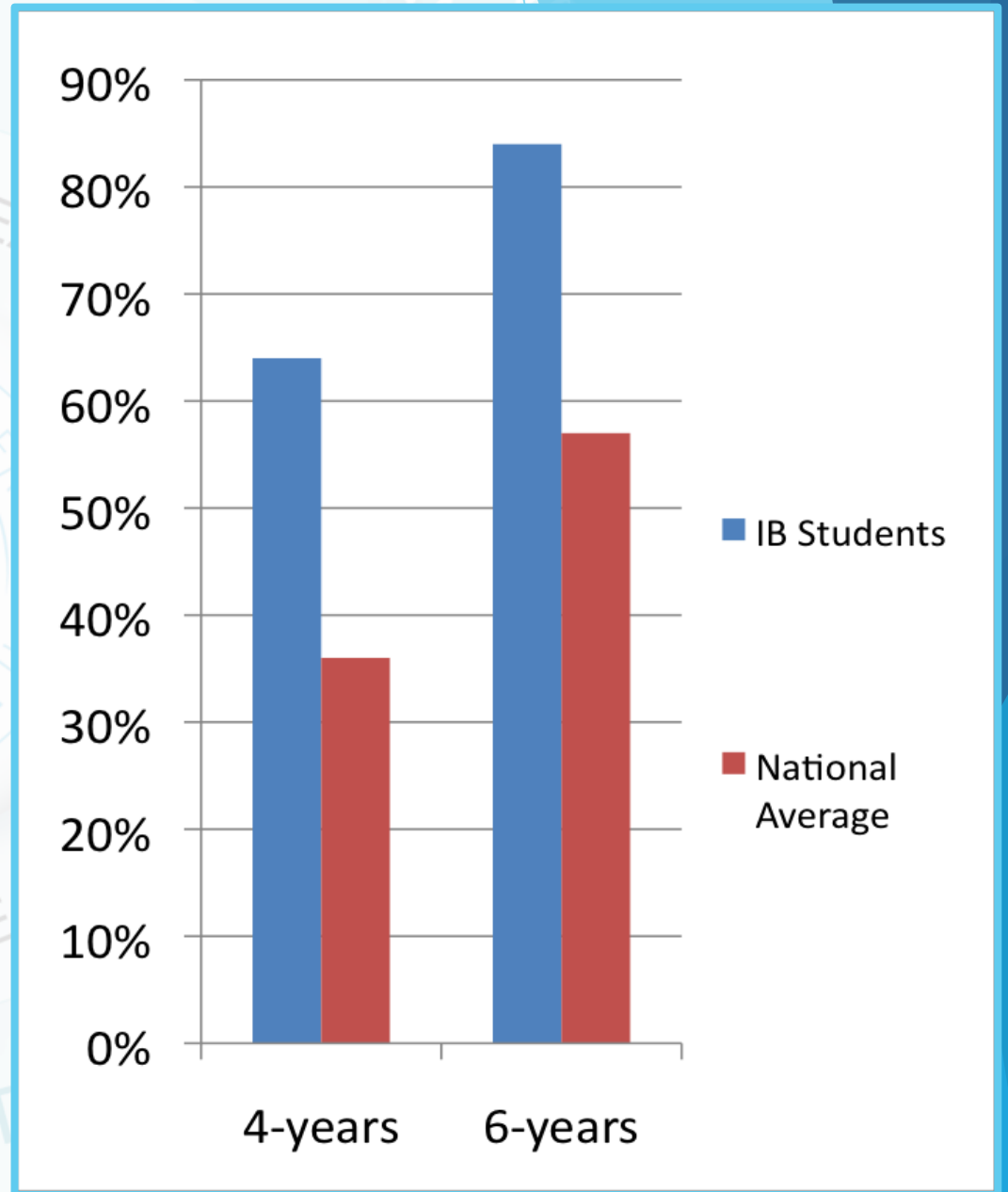
PROOF THAT IB PREPARES

- ▶ Scholarship Opportunities
 - ▶ 100% Bright Futures Scholarship *with* IB Diploma
 - ▶ On average, each graduating IB class earns over **\$5 million** in scholarships (excluding Bright Futures)
- ▶ On average, each IB student earns **24-30 College credits**
- ▶ Helps Build Great College Application
- ▶ Students in top of their class (valedictorian and salutatorian)

PROOF THAT IB PREPARES

- ▶ IB students graduate from college at higher rates.
- ▶ 81% of IB students graduating within 6 years of enrolling full-time at a 4-year institution, compared to the national average of 57%.

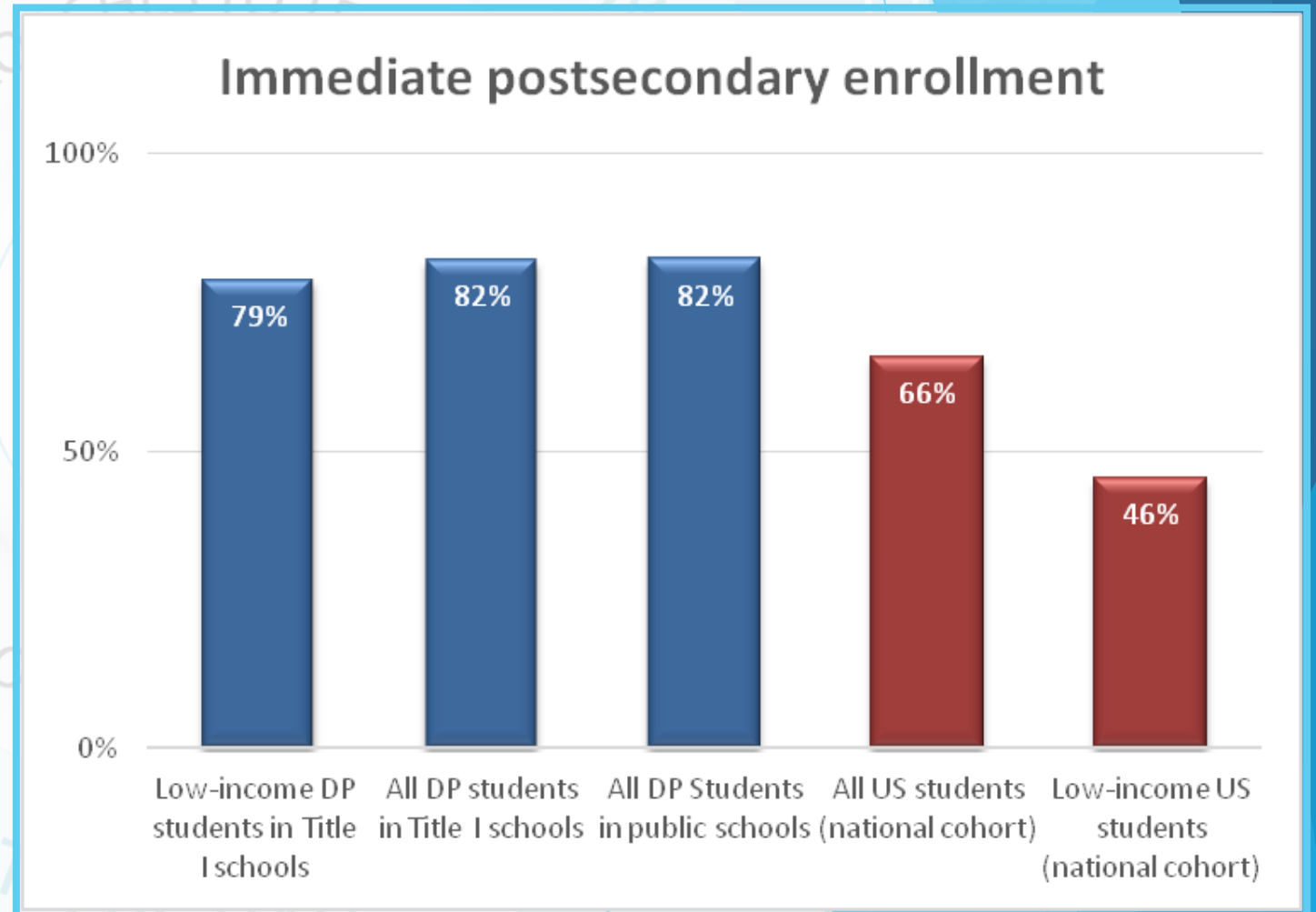

DP students from *Title I* schools enroll in college at much higher rates than the national averages.

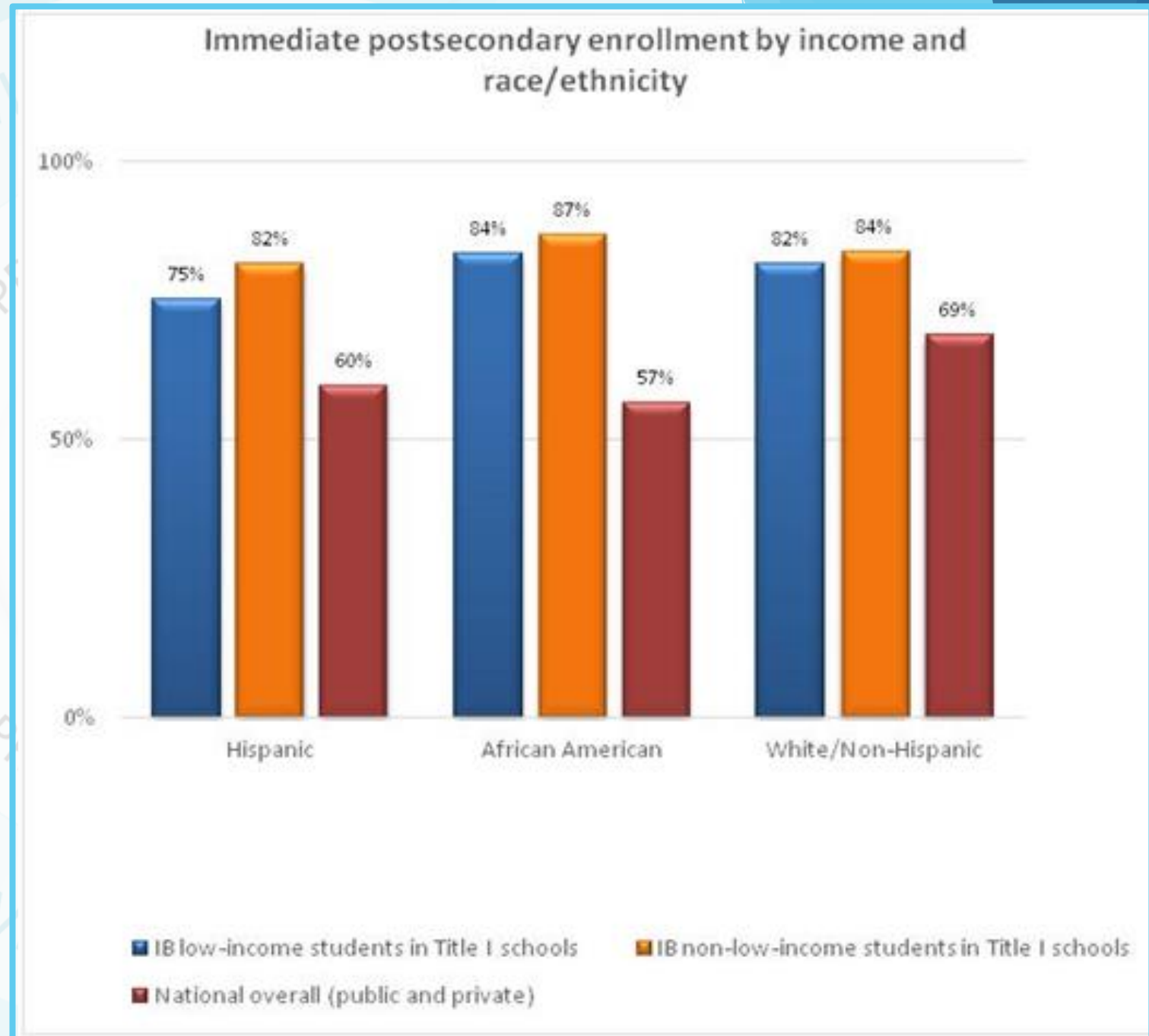
