

THE KOBRIN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Kobrin Family established the Kobrin Family Scholarship Fund in 1990 for qualified students in the Central Florida area. The scholarship is to be used <u>ONLY</u> at the University of Central Florida by a student from Orange, Osceola or Seminole County. **Please note that this scholarship is only available to students of the Jewish faith**.

The scholarship is available in the amount of \$2,500 per year for a maximum of four (4) years to a qualified full-time student. The student must maintain a 3.1 GPA each year in order to remain qualified for the scholarship. The scholarship is disbursed directly to UCF in the amount of \$1,250 for each of the incoming fall and spring semesters.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A completed application packet
- Student must be accepted at and planning to attend the University of Central Florida as a full-time student
- Financial need as demonstrated by the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the FAFSA
- Resident of Orange, Osceola or Seminole County
- High school GPA of at least 3.2 based on a 4.0 scale
- SAT test score of at least 1360 (Reading + Math) or a minimum ACT composite score of 26
- School/Community involvement during high school
- Overall quality of the application
- The committee has the right to consider other factors in awarding the scholarship
