


SENIOR YEAR TIMELINE

Summer Planning



Create your college organizer and list of schools you want to apply to with tuition costs, GPA/testing requirements, etc.

Know your college application deadlines.

Consistently study for the ACT & SAT.

Create your Common App account, complete your Common App tab, and add your colleges.


Do your college essay. Have your college essay proofread.

Ask at least 3 teachers to be a college/scholarship reference.

Apply to colleges that have summer application early deadlines.

SENIOR YEAR TIMELINE

Semester one



Aug-Sept

Complete your Senior Survey with your College & Career Counselor.

Update your high school resume.

Take/Retake the SAT/ACT.

Review & proof your college essay.


Apply to your top schools before the priority decision deadline.

Ask at least 3 teachers to be a college/scholarship reference.

Complete your FAFSA application and submit your confirmation to your College & Career Counselor.

SENIOR YEAR TIMELINE

semester two



Turn in all college acceptances to your College & Career Counselor.

Apply for scholarships and complete your FAFSA application.

Decide which college you will be attending.

Speak to your College Admission Counselor about your Financial Aid.

Complete your Senior Graduation Survey.
