Misc.

No beads are allowed to be worn by anyone! Jewelry worn in a pierced body part other than an ear lobe must be removed. All tattoos must be covered. Hairstyles or hair colors found inappropriate by teen court staff are not permitted. Pants must be pulled up and shirts must be tucked in! NO ONE CAN WEAR FLIP FLOPS!

THE TEEN COURT STAFF HAVE THE FINAL SAY ABOUT WHAT IS ACCEPTABLE. IF YOU ARE UNSURE ABOUT WHETHER A PIECE OF CLOTHING IS APPROPRIATE, BE SAFE AND DO NOT WEAR IT TO COURT.

RULES OF CONDUCT

In order to participate in teen court, you must follow these rules:

- No food, drinks or gum are allowed in the courtroom.
- No illegal substances (this includes cigarettes).
- No Ipods or music devices. Turn off all cell phones.
- Address everyone as "ma'am", "sir", and the judge as "your honor"
- Once court is in session, remain in your seat and don't talk.
- No talking to / from the jury deliberation room.
- Do not leave the courtroom until you are dismissed.
- Uphold the oath of confidentiality and do not discuss any case you hear or see with anyone outside the courtroom and courthouse. Every case you hear is confidential.
- DO NOT BE DISRESPECTFUL TO ANYONE!!! If you make disrespectful comments or gestures towards any member of the Teen Court staff, you will be asked to leave and not return.
