

Clarification regarding the Teacher Salary Increase Allocation (TSIA)

 - *“The term ‘minimum base salary’ means the lowest annual base salary reported on the salary schedule for a full-time classroom teacher.”*
 - *“No full-time classroom teacher shall receive a salary less than the minimum base salary as adjusted by this subparagraph.”*
