Band I – Full year course with no prior experience necessary. (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Band II/III– Full year course for intermediate or advanced bands with prior experience. Students will perform multiple concerts as part of the required course curriculum and practice time is an expectation. The courses will cover music theory and various music styles. (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Chorus I - Basic vocal music-Full Year (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Chorus II - Advanced vocal music interested in community vocal performances - Full Year (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Computer –Divided in to two segments that make a full year course that teaches proficiency in computer technology use.

Culinary - Students learn food basics, healthy eating and proper cooking techniques and more \$

Jazz Band (teacher signature required) – Band or equivalent experience and enrolled in an additional band course. This is an award winning audition group that performs around the county. – full year (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Physical Education - Active participation course which demonstrates a wide variety of skills. This course is included as an option on every student's elective interest. However, some year long elective course may waive a student from participating in a Physical Education course. (P.E. uniform are sold at open house or during first week of the class. \$)

Principals of Food/Nutrition & Wellness – Hands on labs for advanced culinary learning in proper cooking techniques. Students <u>must</u> have completed Fund of Culinary Career last year as a pre-requisite. These courses do affect HS GPA and are worth 0.5 credit each. \$ - full year

STEM for 8th graders – This course is divided into two segments which equal a full year course diving into STEM fields including Robotics. (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Show Choir/Chorus IV (teacher signature required) – Advanced vocals and choreography performance choir– full year (May waive P.E. Option) \$

Spanish I – Full year High school credit course which counts for one foreign language credit on high school transcript. (May waive P.E. Option) This course does affect HS GPA.

Theatre I - full year course that explores theatre's social and cultural influences as well as performance, visual art and music. (May waive P.E. Option) \$
