#### BUSINESS ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES APRIL 28, 2021

Mr. Welch called the meeting to order.

#### **Introductions**

#### Minutes

The minutes from the March 24, 2021, meeting were approved with all ayes.

#### Superintendent Update

Dr. Pace welcomed everyone and was happy to report that the School District is now able to offer six tickets per high school senior for graduations while still following CDC guidelines. She stated the State just released the budget and the school district is slated to receive \$5.3 million dollars for Funding Compression and \$2.9 million for Mental Health. Dr. Pace reported that Osceola County has moved up from 67<sup>th</sup> to 61<sup>st</sup> in per student funding amongst the 67 school districts in the state.

Dr. Pace provided an update on Federal ESSER funding which will aid in academic learning programs and reimburse the District for Covid related expenses.

Dr. Pace mentioned that the School Board approved that the District offer only face-to-face learning or traditional virtual school for next school year. She stated the District will reconvene the Back to School Task Force and work with infectious disease experts in implementing CDC guidelines effectively. Dr. Pace cited that the District continues to work with the Department of Health to get employees vaccinated.

#### Impact Fee and Sales Tax Reports

Maribel Vallellanes reviewed the Impact Fee & Sales Tax Reports as of February 28, 2021.

#### BUSINESS ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES APRIL 28, 2021

Mr. Welch brought up the campaign for renewal of the Osceola County penny sales tax. Dr. Pace said she has a meeting set up with the other governmental agencies to discuss the next campaign.

There was a brief discussion regarding adjusting this year's Sales Tax Revenue Forecast down due to current collections being below budget. The Board agreed to amend the School Capital Outlay Surtax forecast down to \$26M. The motion passed with all ayes.

There was a brief discussion regarding adjusting this year's Infrastructure Sales Tax Revenue Forecast. The Board agreed to amend the forecast down to \$13M. The motion passed with all ayes.

#### Budget Update

Ms. Sarah Graber shared that district staff will be working through the budget process over the next several weeks and will hold a budget workshop with the School Board on June 1<sup>st</sup>.

There was a brief discussion on SRO's in schools. Dr. Pace provided an update and indicated that the law enforcement agencies are committed to providing SRO's for each of the traditional schools and discussing the possibility of a Guardian Program option for charter schools.

#### Facilities Update & Planning Department

Mr. Clinch thanked the Board for their continued support. Mr. Clinch, Mr. Lockard, and Ms. Blake presented a Facilities Update and Planning Update. Celebration Isle Elementary School, Neptune Middle School Rear Bus Loop and various Projects in Design and Construction were discussed. Mr. Lockard provided an aerial picture on the progress of the construction at Canoe Creek K-8 and Liberty High School.

There was a brief discussion on the Transportation East and Transportation West projects.

Dr. Pace mentioned she is very proud of the outstanding work her leadership team, teachers, and staff have accomplished during these challenging times. She stated that next week is Teacher & Staff Appreciation Week. In a token of appreciation from the School Board and Leadership Team, every employee will receive a donut.

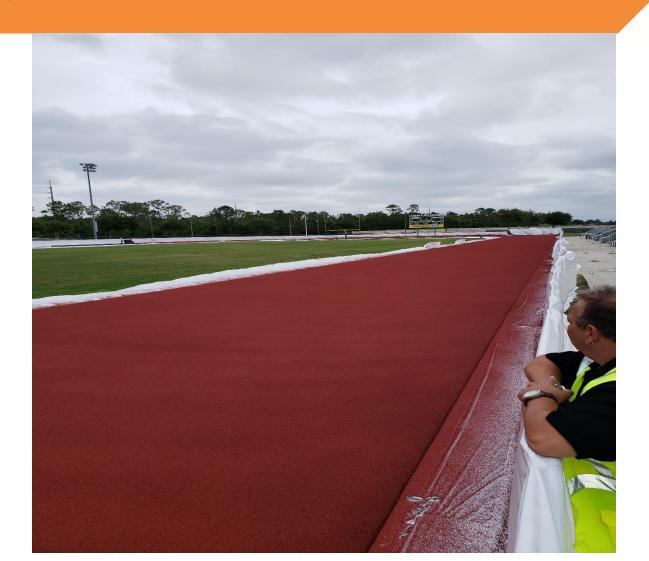
